1 BASIC CUSTOMIZATION

To access the customization setting, click the hamburger **menu** icon and select **Settings**.

At the top of the settings page, in the **Customization** section, are the basic customization options for the SafeCount displays.

The screen that shows for the browser, when signed in, on any given device can be selected here. The options are:

- Customer View
- Attendant View

This allows a customer facing screen to default to the **Customer View**, whilst a colleague's device could default to the **Attendant View**.

Basic customization allows the changing of two text elements on the SafeCount screens.

- **Title** This is the text that appears in the top left of the SafeCount screens, often used for the location or zone name being monitored for occupancy.
- Last Updated Prefix This is the prefix text for the date/time when the screen last received occupancy data (used for ensuring that the screen is showing the latest live information)





Further down the **Settings** page, the advanced customization options can be found in a section titled **Customization (Customer View Advanced)**.





Click on the question mark next to any entry to see a dialogue box with information of what the setting does and how to change it.



Ticking the checkbox next to any of the options selects whether that text or element will be visible on the screen and will open any additional settings that can be changed.

The **Logo Image** allows you to upload a logo file for each occupancy level (Safe, High, Max) and adjust its size on the screen.

The logo is displayed in the bottom right corner of the Customer View screen.
