The Challenge

During the 2015-16 school year, Oaks Christian School (OCS) with an enrollment of 1,400 servicing grades 5-12 wanted to learn more about how parents felt about their online experience on the school's website. They administered a survey that would assess the current value and state of the OCS website. After the survey was completed, there was constructive feedback suggesting several improvements to the OCS website. The first feedback that caught OCS's eye was that they wanted a central access point to all their resources on the website. This would make it easier for parents to navigate through a content/app heavy website. This then sparked the idea of integrating all content/apps into a user-friendly site. "Oaks account requirements are constantly changing. I have at least 20 different accounts and passwords – why can't there be one login that gets us to everything?" said one OCS parent. Lastly, and probably the biggest concern from the survey, was the idea that there wasn't one login to access all the accounts. SSO provides this, but OCS demanded that it came with enhanced security/functionality.
