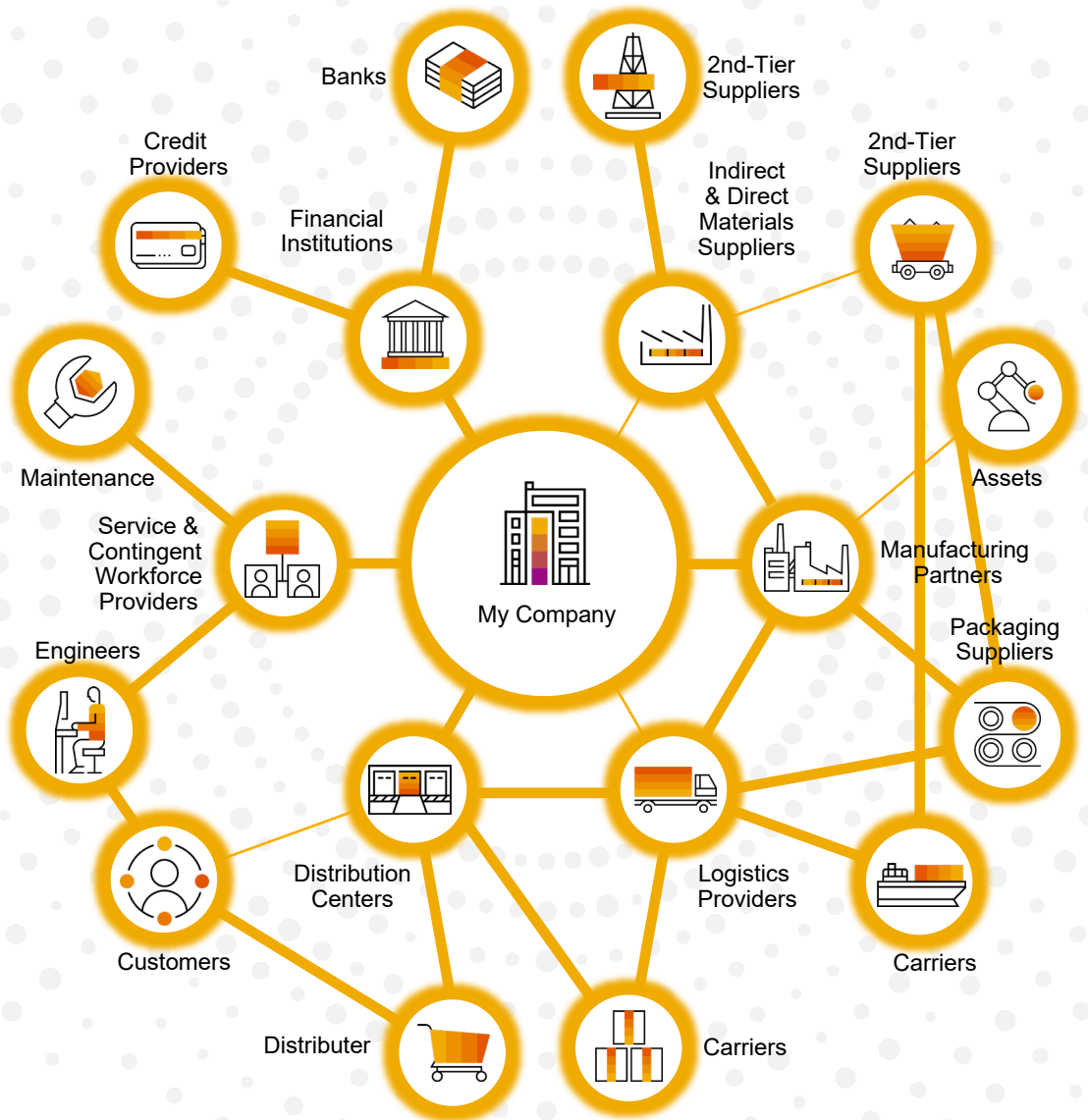

What is the value of a unified business network?

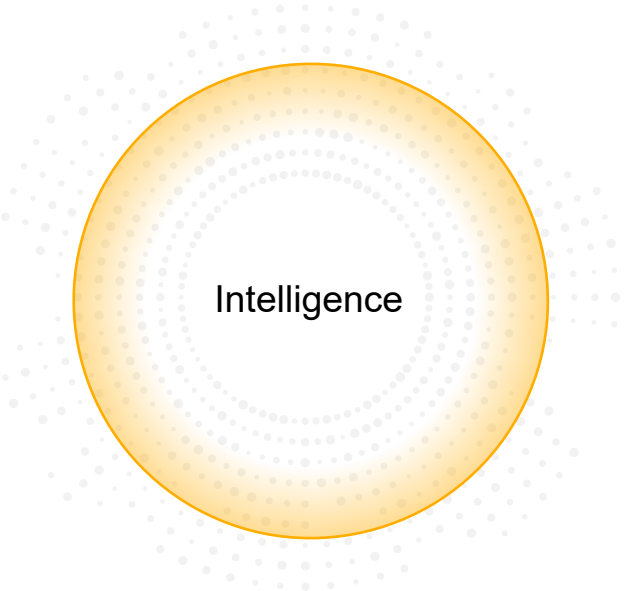
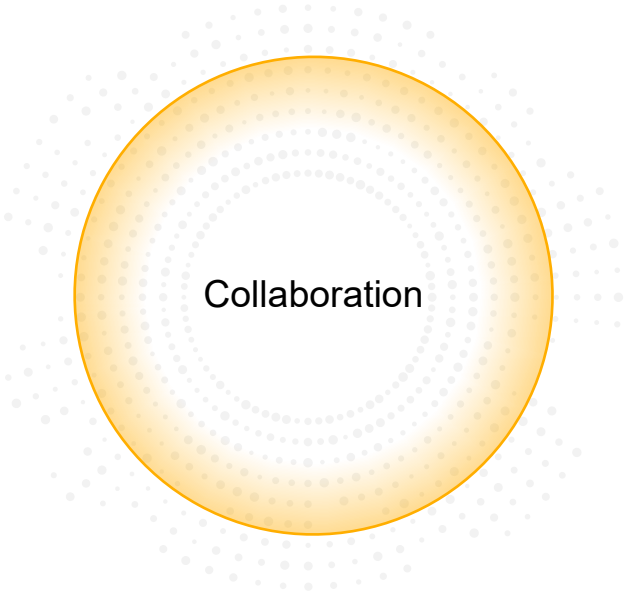
A company works with a contract manufacturer, who in turn relies on a packaging and parts supplier, who in turn relies on raw material suppliers.

They ship finished goods to a Distribution Center, who then transports to a distributor, who then sells to a customer.

And they all rely on carriers to get everything where it needs to go, and a financial network to pay for everything.

And, if the equipment requires maintenance, a service engineer is contracted to fix it under a maintenance contract.
