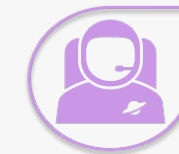

Terms & Conditions

*Audit Programs attract no additional fees other than those advertised above. Completion of Audit Module requirements will be acknowledged by a Certificate of Completion authorised by CIRCLE – The Centre for Innovation, Research, Creativity and Leadership in Education and Alphacrucis College. Participants who complete Audit Modules can accumulate them progressively; an approved study pattern of 4 Modules can be upgraded to a Course. Participants who successfully complete Audit Courses can apply for these to be transferred to Credit status upon completion of payment of Credit Program Assessment Fees.

#Credit Programs involve completion of a study program of our Audit Modules and Courses. In addition to the fees advertised and normal Audit Course requirements, participants complete additional assessment programs and pay a Credit Program Assessment Fees that covers the administration of an additional assessment program and the accreditation of the program with CIRCLE – The Centre for Innovation, Research, Creativity and Leadership in Education and Alphacrucis College. Credit Program Assessment Fees are available POA and will largely depend on the level of accreditation sought.
