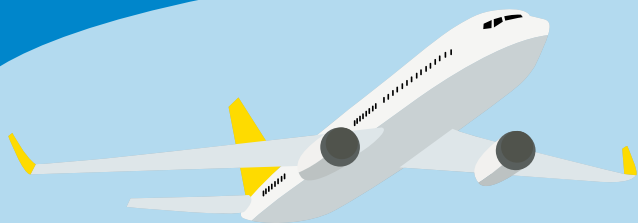


Keeping your crew moving

Private charters for the energy and shipping industries were almost unheard of, however since March 2020, with lockdowns and global travel becoming increasingly difficult, they have become crucial for keeping the world's seafarers and offshore crew moving.

We're proud to have been able to support both industries and in celebration of World Maritime Day on the 24th September, we have collated our charter achievements from the past 6 months.



We organised **100+** charter operations. on **35+** different routes with many of these routes including multiple rotations.

The largest operation was the transportation of

15,000

Indian seafarers from Mumbai & Delhi to Doha, where they were then able to access worldwide connections.



The charters operated from all regions of the world, including:

Regular rotations from Europe to Angola and Namibia, despite both countries being in total lockdown.

Mobilising cruise ship crew stranded in Norway to Manila.

Other popular locations for the charters included Gdansk, Gibraltar, Las Palmas and Miri.

A significant number of charters between Houston and Ciudad Del Carmen in Mexico.

Moving crew throughout Asia and primarily into Manila and Singapore.
