## FOCUS ON 4 ASIA MARKETS:

- Philippines: Domestic travel, entry quota, international connections and guarantine facilities
- Singapore: Crew change regulations and transit passengers
- Hong Kong: Improved immigration for seafarers, max transit of 8 hours
- India: Lockdown status, entry rules for Indian Nationals, charter opportunities



### **PHILIPPINES**

Domestic Travel: Clark, Cebu and Davao re-opened Local governments requirements International traffic

- Arrivals: Arrival quota at 600/day (across 3 PH and 22 Intl. Airlines) Frequent changes in government restrictions
- Departures
- Charter flights No quota, when approved by government News, updates and outlook coming week
- 15 June update quarantine measures

## SINGAPORE

Current status of relieved lockdown since 22 May However, complicating crew change conditions

- Onsigners: Arrivals possible from China, NZ and Australia
- Offsigners: vessel cannot leave port before offsigning crew departed

Transit passengers allowed since 02 June



- Airlines need to apply for individual transit permission
- Transit conditions apply

Announcements expected by next Friday 19 June on updated crew change policy

## HONG KONG



#### **Current status for Crew Changes**

- Crew changes permitted for all goods vessels, without quarantine
- Offsigners need head straight to airport
- Onsigners can await ship for 72 hours

Transit passengers allowed, but cannot leave airport, max 8 hour transit

 Cathay Pacific looking to improve network better to accommodate transit trave

Political situation / civil unrest appears relatively stable?

#### **INDIA**

#### Lockdown status:

- International flights remain suspended
- Indian nationals depend on Air India repatriation flights
- No transit passengers accepted

#### **ATPI Crew change charters:**

- In cooperation with FOSSMA and MASSA associations
- Delhi Doha Delhi, every 4 days until end of June
- · Seats allocated to association members
- Spare seats sold to non-members
