### CMS is waiving PECOS Applications fees?

- New applications, revalidations and reactivations
- Perfect for Pharmacies looking to start an Immunization Program, or for those looking to start/restart DMEPOS, or wishing to offer Non-Accredited Drugs
- Fees waived through September 30, 2021 then fees go back to \$599 per application

### DEA record-keeping violations can be up to \$14,502 per occurrence?

- Initial and Date all line items on Packing invoices and staple to hard copy 222
- POA's required for individuals who have signing authority for PIC. Be sure to complete DEA forms 251, 252, and 253 and keep on file with signed POA for each certificate holder

### CMS is now doing virtual inspections?

- 1-2 weeks notice
- Checking for same information as on-site inspections
- Prepare in advance by printing all information requested in Pre Inspection Checklist

### The Draft NIOSH list is still pending?

- Closed to public comment December 2020
- Drugs will be moving tables, new notes, and guidance
- USP will be officially in charge of Hazardous Drug usage
- Table 2 and Table 3's should be allowed in automation systems, robots, and pill counters

### HIPAA turns 25 this year & is getting an update?

- Focus on data transmission and data sharing
- Public comment has closed, waiting for draft to adopted
