# Practice-Changing Pharmacy Updates

#### **Dexamethasone and COVID-19**

Pain Point: A recent study from the U.K. has raised a lot of questions about whether dexamethasone is a "breakthrough" in treating COVID-19. This contradicts early guidance to avoid steroids for COVID-19 due to a lack of benefit and possible harm seen in SARS.

Solution: This month's <u>Hospital</u>
<u>Pharmacist's Letter article-in</u>
<u>progress</u> breaks down the caveats of the study, and includes guidance for which patients should receive steroids, recommended dosing, and potential adverse effects.
