STUDENTS: New Isolation and Quarantine Guidelines Per CDC Update 12/27/2021

If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.

Stay home for 5 days.

Contact the Dean of Students Office and reach out to your instructors to determine how you can continue your coursework remotely. (deanofstudents@jwcc.edu, 217.641.4358 or complete the COVID form at www.jwcc.edu/coronavirus.)

- If you are asymptomatic, or began with symptoms, but they are resolving after 5 days, you may be released from isolation after day 5. Students will be contacted by the Dean of Students Office on day 5 to check in to formally approve return to class. Please watch for a call, email, or text and respond promptly.
- For an additional five days, continue to wear a well-fitting face covering around others. It should fully cover
 your mouth and nose. (Note that face coverings are always required inside any JWCC facility regardless of COVID
 status).
- If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

If You Are Exposed to a COVID-19 Positive Individual (Quarantine)

If you:

Have been boosted

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last six months.

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last two months.

- For 10 days, wear well-fitting face covering around all others. It should fully cover your mouth and nose. (Note that face coverings are always required inside any JWCC facility regardless of COVID status).
- If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home. Contact the Dean of Students for further guidance.

If you:

Are unvaccinated

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine more than six months ago and are not boosted **OR**

Completed the primary series of J&J more than two months ago and are not boosted

• Stay home for 5 days. After that wear well-fitting face covering around all others for 5 additional days. It should fully cover your mouth and nose. (Note that face coverings are always required inside any JWCC facility regardless of COVID status).

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home and contact the Dean of Students Office <u>deanofstudents@jwcc.edu</u>, 217.641.4358. Please note: Protocols are subject to change as the pandemic and guidelines evolve.
