**Notice:** BioSURF Manufacture Changes

Dear **PureWay Valued Customer**,

Due to a recent decision made by the United States Department of Transport (US DOT) and subsequent Canadian Dangerous Goods regulations, the manufacture of BioSURF, Micrylium Laboratories, has been instructed to stop all shipments of the 5L BioSURF (US SKU# 60132). It has been brought to our attention that the US DOT has determined that the UN classification is 1170 (Pure Ethanol) rather than 1266 that Micrylium has utilized for many years. This resulted in the halt of production and shipment of the 5L bag in the Box of BioSURF.

Micrylium has swiftly come to a solution regarding this issue to ensure there will be no further delays or any further inconvenience for all customers. In replacement of the 5L bag in the box of BioSURF, Micrylium has produced a 1L bag in the box version of the 5L. The new packaging will contain five (5) individual 1L bags in separate boxes. All five boxes will then be packaged into one larger box. The new packaging now qualifies for the Dangerous Goods exemption 1L for the UN 1170. There will be no current pricing changes at this time.

We will provide a copy of the notice issued by Micrylium regarding the BioSURF manufacture changes for your records.

Concerning 5L shipments of BioSURF

Dear valued Client,

Due to a decision by the US Department of Transport and subsequent Canadian Dangerous Goods regulations, we have been instructed to stop all shipments of 5L BioSURF. They have determined that the UN classification is 1170 (pure Ethanol) rather than the 1266 that we had used for many years. This means we cannot ship the 5L as we did in the past.

Our plan right now is to substitute 1L bag-in-box versions of BioSURF at this point. Boxes have been ordered and will be available next week. Pricing will be the same and it will qualify for the Dangerous Goods exemption of 1L for the UN 1170.
