

Safety iPass Simplifies Reporting for Administrators

The Challenge

The Academy of the Holy Names was struggling to educate young women safely during the COVID-19 pandemic. The New York school was remote from March through the end of the school year, but over the summer, the state challenged schools to figure out how to make in-person instruction work for the new school year.

"We wanted to know: how can we best know about the health of all members of our community...But we also needed a way to ensure that anyone coming into the school was safe to come into the school...How do we keep instructing the students the best we can? Where do we do it? Do we do it in the school or do we do it remotely?"

The Solution

The Academy of the Holy Names chose Safety iPass from CrisisGo because it was "the most efficient product" on the market to address their COVID concerns.

Parents complete a health screening questionnaire for their student each morning and the student receives a color-coded access badge to enter the building.

"The scanner will just read their [badge] and let us know whether they can come in or not, so it doesn't cause a back-up at the door...we know that whoever is coming in to the building has attested to the fact that they have not had any of the symptoms of COVID, nor have they been in contact [with someone who does.]"

The Results

"We know it's working because we've only had one student come in to the building that has caused us to go remote...It provides a sense of safety that we need for our community because one of the most important things about a school is for everyone in that building to feel safe."

When the school did have to quarantine, administrators were able to adjust the questionnaire to continue monitoring symptoms and tracking student health. "We learn about positive cases through the app, even when we're remote."

Safety iPass also made state-mandated reporting faster and more efficient.

"Every day, whether we're in person or remote, I have to make a report to the school health survey...How many were in school? How many were out of school? The same for the faculty and staff. I get that information by going to the dashboard. It's unbelievable. It makes the reporting seamless. It's really easy."
