COVID Updates from the Alberta Government

We are pleased to bring you Alberta's COVID-19 updates announced on December 15th.

Rapid Test Kits

As of today, Rapid Test kits containing five tests will be available to Albertans free of charge at select AHS locations and pharmacies while supplies last. This will allow Albertans to do a simple COVID test at home. Learn more at alberta.ca/rapidtesting

3rd Doses of

Albertans aged 50 and older <u>and</u> all health care workers are now eligible for a third dose provided it has been 6 months or longer since their previous vaccine. Visit <u>bookvaccine.alberta.ca</u> or call 811 to book an appointment.

Indoor Social Gatherings

Indoor social gatherings are no longer limited to two households. Indoor social gatherings can now be up to 10 vaccinated or unvaccinated adults. There are no limits for children under the age of 18.

Individuals attending larger gatherings should do their best to wear masks and physically distance where possible. In addition, it is strongly recommended that Rapid Antigen Test Kits are used to test attendees – especially if they are unvaccinated.



Outdoor Social Gatherings

Outdoor social gatherings remain limited to a maximum of 20 people, with 2-metre physical distancing between households at all times.
