## Sample Weekly Plan for a Synchronous Fourth Grade Student

> Synchronous students have a combination of both SYNC and ASYNC classes.

SYNC (Synchronous) - Certified teachers instruct students in a live online class setting Monday through Thursday.
ASYNC (Asynchronous) - Coursework is planned and supervised by a certified teacher. The Learning Coach implements the teacher's plan using the provided curriculum \& online resources to instruct their child(ren) on a daily basis. While class instruction is highly suggested to be completed during daylight hours, there is flexibility for the Learning Coach to choose when each subject is completed.
