Required Equipment

- · Phillips head screwdriver
- Power source: Ethernet cable
- Drill with ¼" drill bit

Inspection

Ensure that the device is in good condition and all the assembly parts are included.


- Make sure that all equipment is powered off during installation.
- Ensure the mounting surface is strong enough to withstand three times the weight of the camera and the mount
- If the product does not function properly, please contact technical support. Do not disassemble the camera for repair or maintenance.

Overview


Before installing, familiarize yourself with the parts of the camera.



Installation

1. Drill a cable hole and ¼" pilot holes, using the supplied template.


2. Using the provided hex-key, loosen the machine screw on the side and remove the base.




Note: When removing the base, do so on a flat surface to avoid dropping the camera body.

Installation

3. Insert the drywall anchors. Secure the base to the mounting surface using provided screws.



4. Connect an ethernet cable that is connected to the desired POE enabled network into the camera's ethernet adapter.




Installation

5. Rotate the camera body to the desired viewing angle.

6. Snap the camera body into the base.

7. Using the provided hex-key, tighten the machine screw on the side until the camera body is secured firmly to the base.



Note: A small "lip" is present on the inside of the base. Secure the interlocking ridges underneath this lip before attempting to snap into place.

Camera Setup & Default Password IMPORTANT NOTE: The default camera setup password is the <u>FIRST 6 Characters</u> of the UUID/SN.
