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| Program Overview | Academic and personal support to increase retention and graduation rates of participants at the Tampa campus of USF | Direct Freshman admission to all USF campuses for students at select public high schools who meet minimum GPA and SAT/ACT score requirements | Financial assistance, support and enrichment to students from migrant and seasonal farmworker backgrounds |
| Students Who Can Qualify | First-generation college students and/or have a low-income family status | Students at qualifying local public schools in the Tampa Bay region | Full-time, first-time-in-college (FTIC) students meeting at least one of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Worked 75+ days in past 24 months as a seasonal/migrant farmworker or have a parent who did • Participated in a Title 1 Migrant Education Program or are eligible • Qualified for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title I Sec. 167 |
| Requirements | General admission to USF as a freshman student for Summer semester entry | GPA: 3.7 and SAT: 1100 or ACT: 22 Lower GPAs can be considered with higher test scores, or lower test scores can be considered with higher GPAs | General admission to USF as a freshman, submit an application to CAMP and complete the free application for federal student aid (FAFSA) |
| Perks | Numerous services: individualized academic advising, counseling, coaching, financial aid assistance, and social and cultural enrichment programs | Priority consideration for an academic award of up to \$2,000 through the History of Achievement Scholarship | Application processing help (admissions, financial aid, housing and more), tutoring, advising, advocacy, mentorship, health services, cultural activities and transitional services |

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| Program Overview | Seamless pathway from local community or state colleges to any USF campus | Seamless pathway from St. Petersburg College (SPC) to the St. Petersburg campus of USF | Transfer to the St. Petersburg campus in spring following one semester at another college or university | Offers a credit-bearing semester abroad so that you can graduate in four years from USF's Tampa or St. Petersburg campus |
| Students Who Can Qualify | Students enrolled at local community or state colleges | Students enrolled at St. Petersburg College who want to transfer to USF's St. Petersburg campus to complete their bachelor's degree | Students living outside Pinellas County who complete 12 credit hours at another college or university the summer or fall after graduating from high school | First-time-in-college students may apply through Verto Education's website |
| Requirements | Earn an Associate of Arts degree (or articulated Associate of Science degree) before finishing with a bachelor's at USF | Students enrolled at SPC must participate in workshops and meet with their counselor on a regular basis | Minimum of 12 transferable post-secondary credits at an accredited college/university with a minimum of a 2.5 overall transferable postsecondary GPA* <i>*Check the website for major-specific requirements for this program</i> | Qualify for admission to USF after satisfactory completion of studies through Verto |
| Perks | Guaranteed admission to USF, prerequisite checks for transferring, scholarship eligibility at SPC and USF and events/workshops | Eligibility for a generous, partial tuition scholarship to USF's St. Petersburg campus upon transfer | Dedicated admission and advising support and a \$1,000 scholarship for the first spring semester | Study abroad and earn college credit for USF. Become a global leader, gain confidence, and make an impact when you arrive on campus |
