accommodations

- To make this program dementia-friendly, read the famous duos questions with their answers as "fun facts".
- Play in any size group. Ideal for a hallway activity or one-to-one.

instructions

Preparing for the Activity

Prepare Eversound as needed by connecting headphones, passing them out to residents, and utilizing the microphone so residents can hear directions.

Setting the Stage

Do as little explaining as possible. Simply begin offering the duo names – in context, if possible.

Famous Duos

- Encourage the resident(s) to recall the name of the second person in the duo.
- Encourage storytelling about the duo.

Wrapping Up

Ask the resident(s) for their own suggestions for famous duos!
