Homemade Dog Treats

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup milk, low or fat free
- 1 cup peanut butter, natural or organic
- 3 cups rolled oats

Instructions:

1. Stir vigorously to combine the first two ingredients in a large bowl.
2. Slowly stir (and mash) in the oats, about a 1/2 cup at a time. The mixture will be very thick.
3. Scoop out the peanut butter balls with a cookie scooper. Then roll with damp hands until you create a uniform ball shape.
4. Place on a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper.
5. Refrigerate for at least 1 hour.

Crinkle Water Bottle Toys for Dogs

You will need: Old Sweater or sock; Empty water bottle (REMOVE LABEL, CAP, AND RING), Scissors

Instructions:

- 1) Place the water bottle inside the arm of the sweater (or sock)
- 2) Cut the arm of the sweater (or tip of sock) so there is enough fabric on each end
- 3) Tie a knot at each end of the sweater (or sock) so it hugs the bottle tightly
- 4) Cut strips on each end of the knots



*If you are super crafty and like to sew, this project can also be done with fleece fabric
