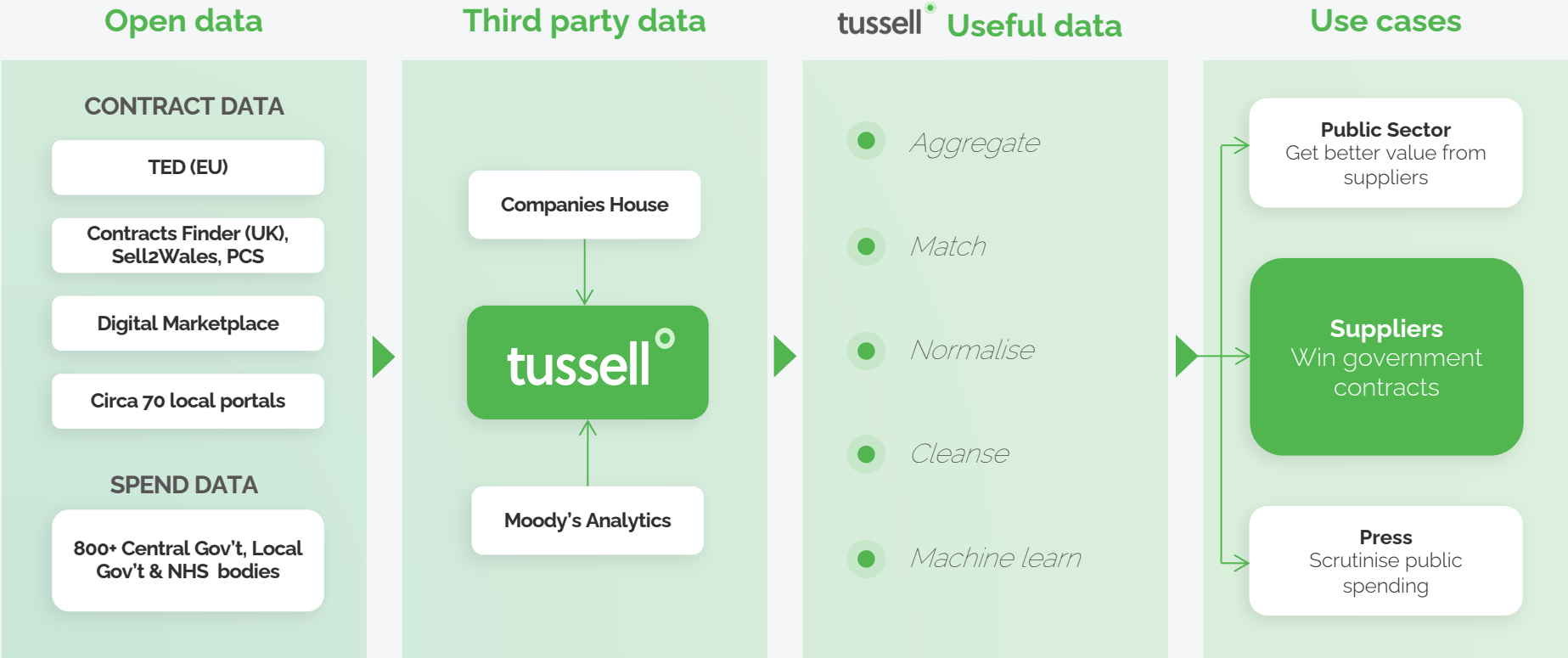

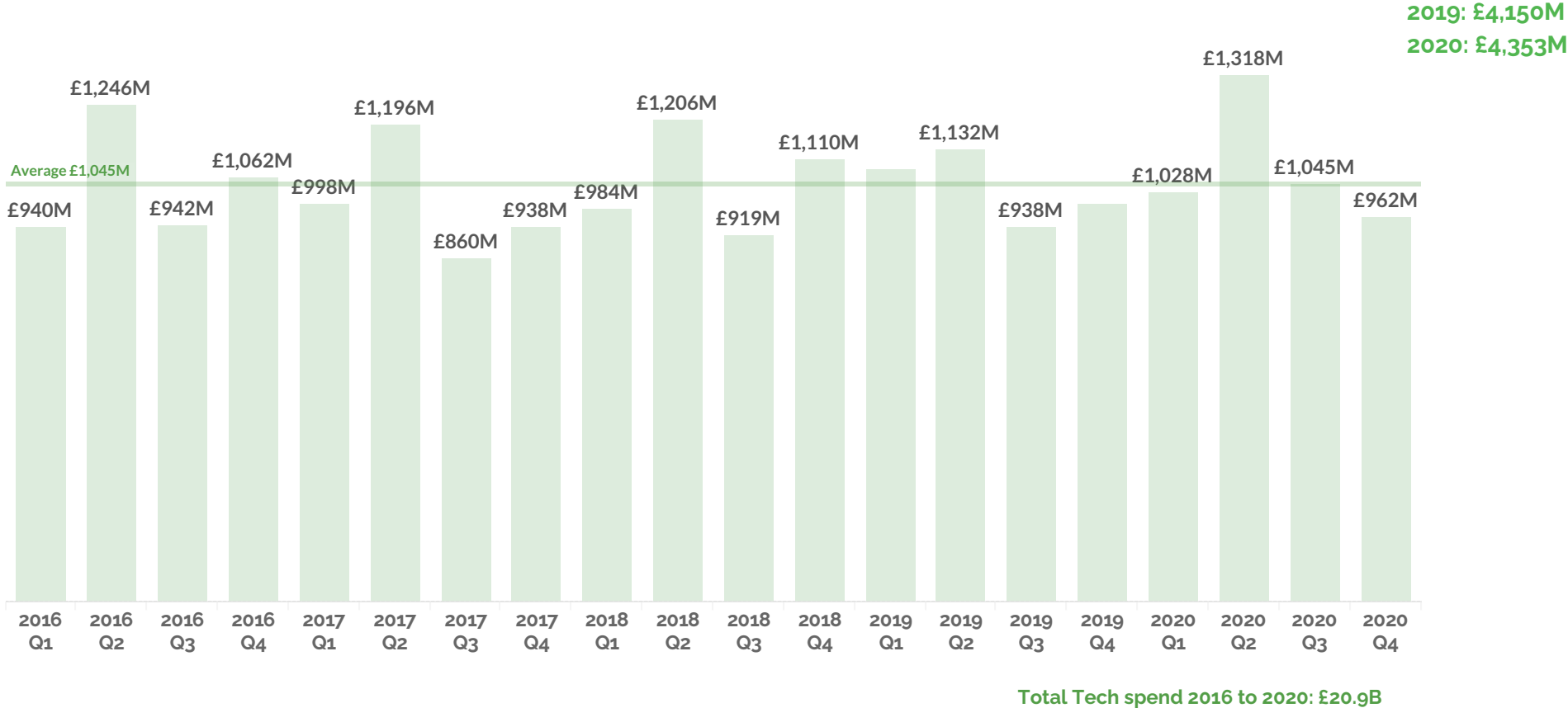

Central Government IT spend peaked in Q2 2020 and grew by 5% or £200M in 2020

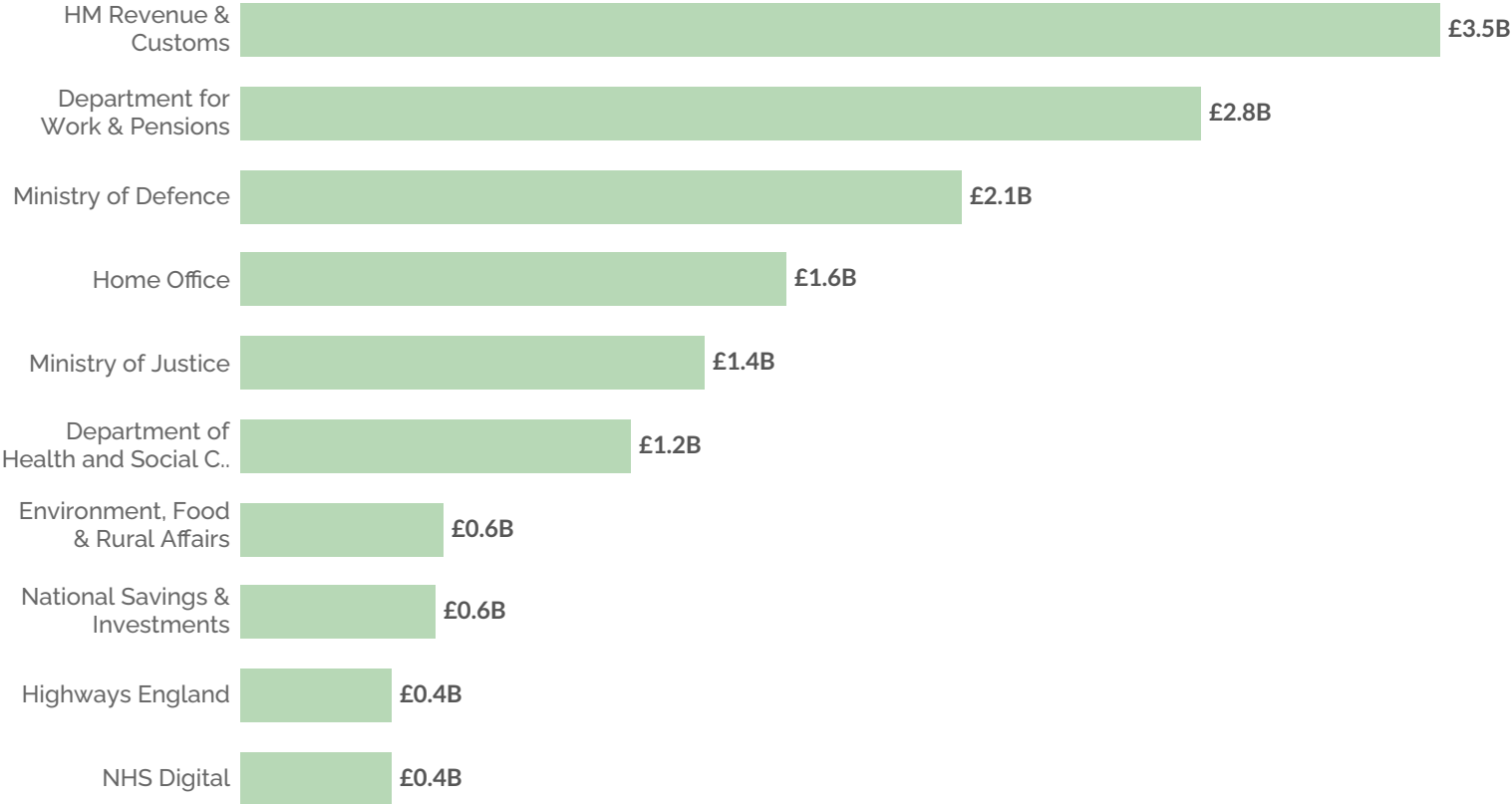
Central Government quarterly spending (£) on IT and technology firms, Q1 2016- Q4 2020



HMRC leads in IT spend as it continues to modernise its IT infrastructure and moves towards a digital tax system

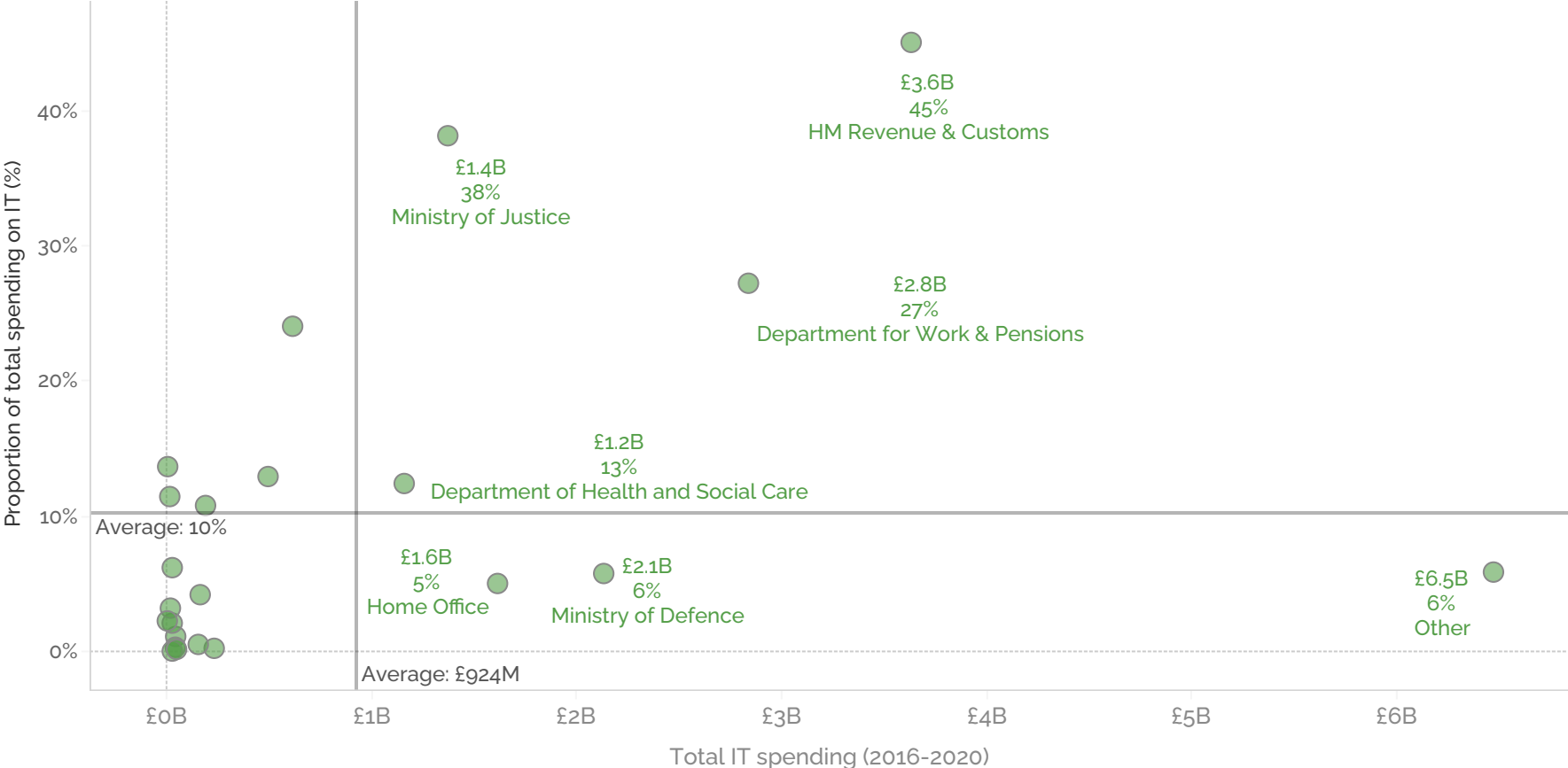
Top 10 Central Government departments by IT spend (£), 2016-2020

The Treasury expects an additional £180M will be invested in 2021-22 in new technology for HMRC



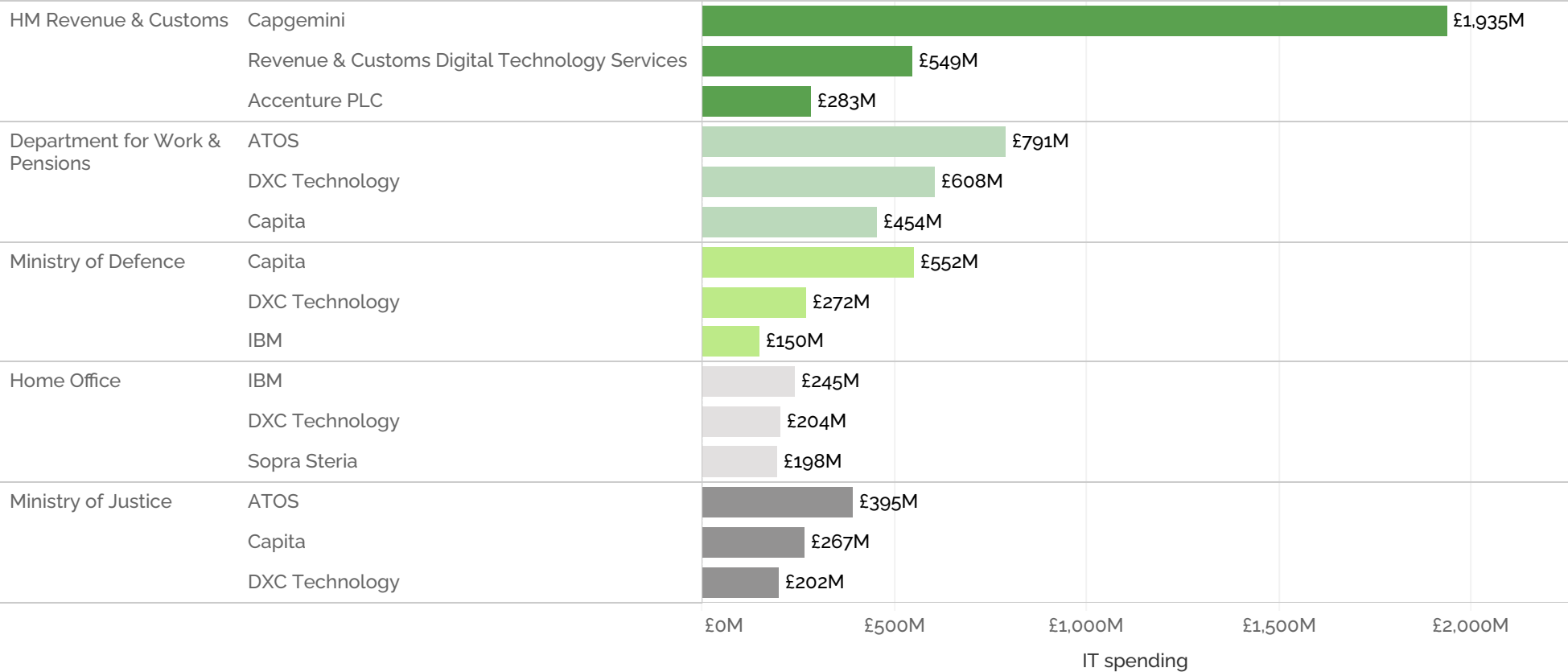
Since 2016 Central Government bodies on average have spent £924M on IT - or 10% of their total budgets. However, the distribution varies widely

Department-level spending on IT (£) vs. IT as a proportion of total spending (%), 2016-2020



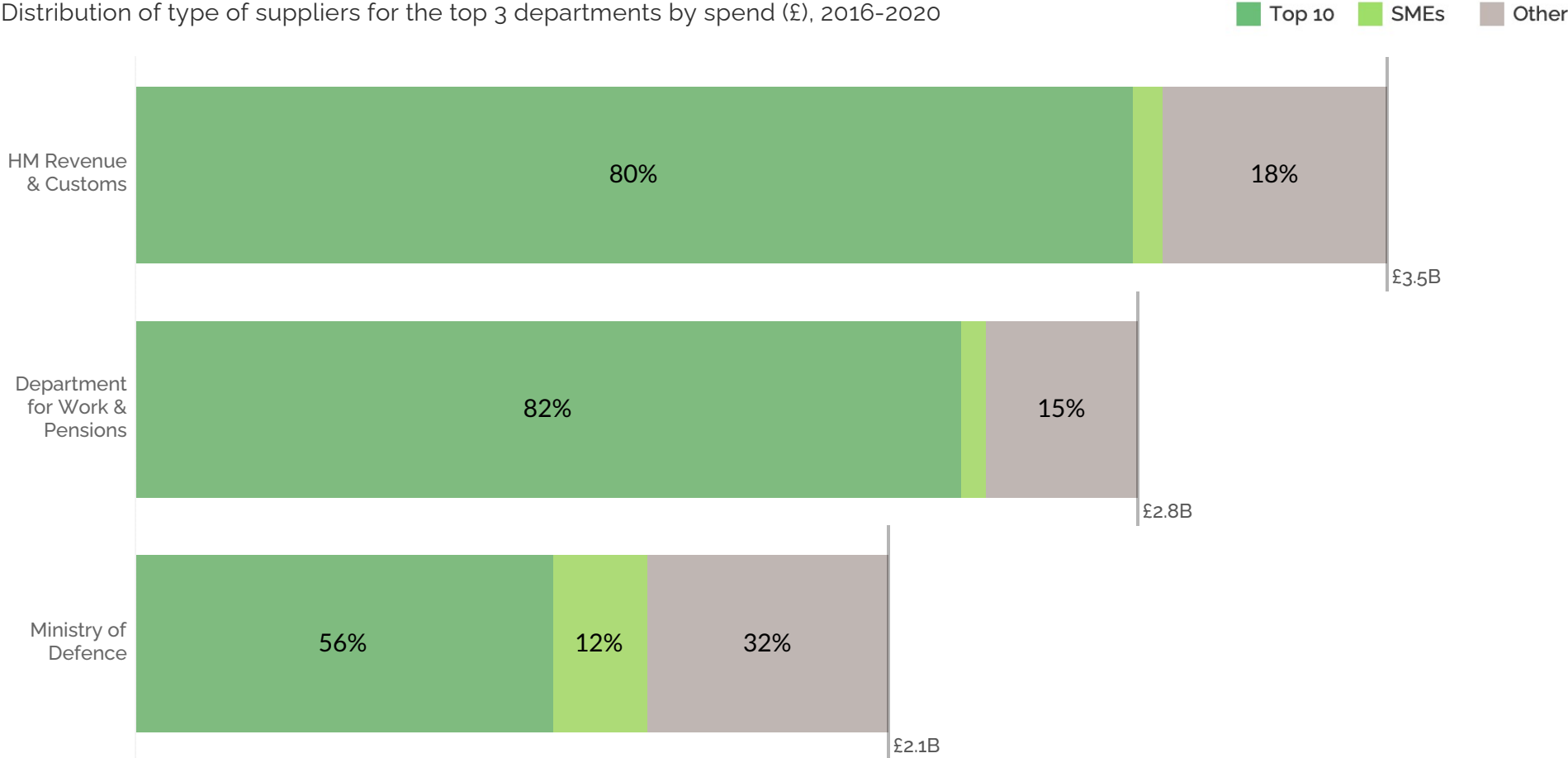
HMRC appears to be more reliant on its top IT supplier than the other top-spending departments

Top 5 departments by spend (£) and their top 3 IT suppliers, 2016-2020



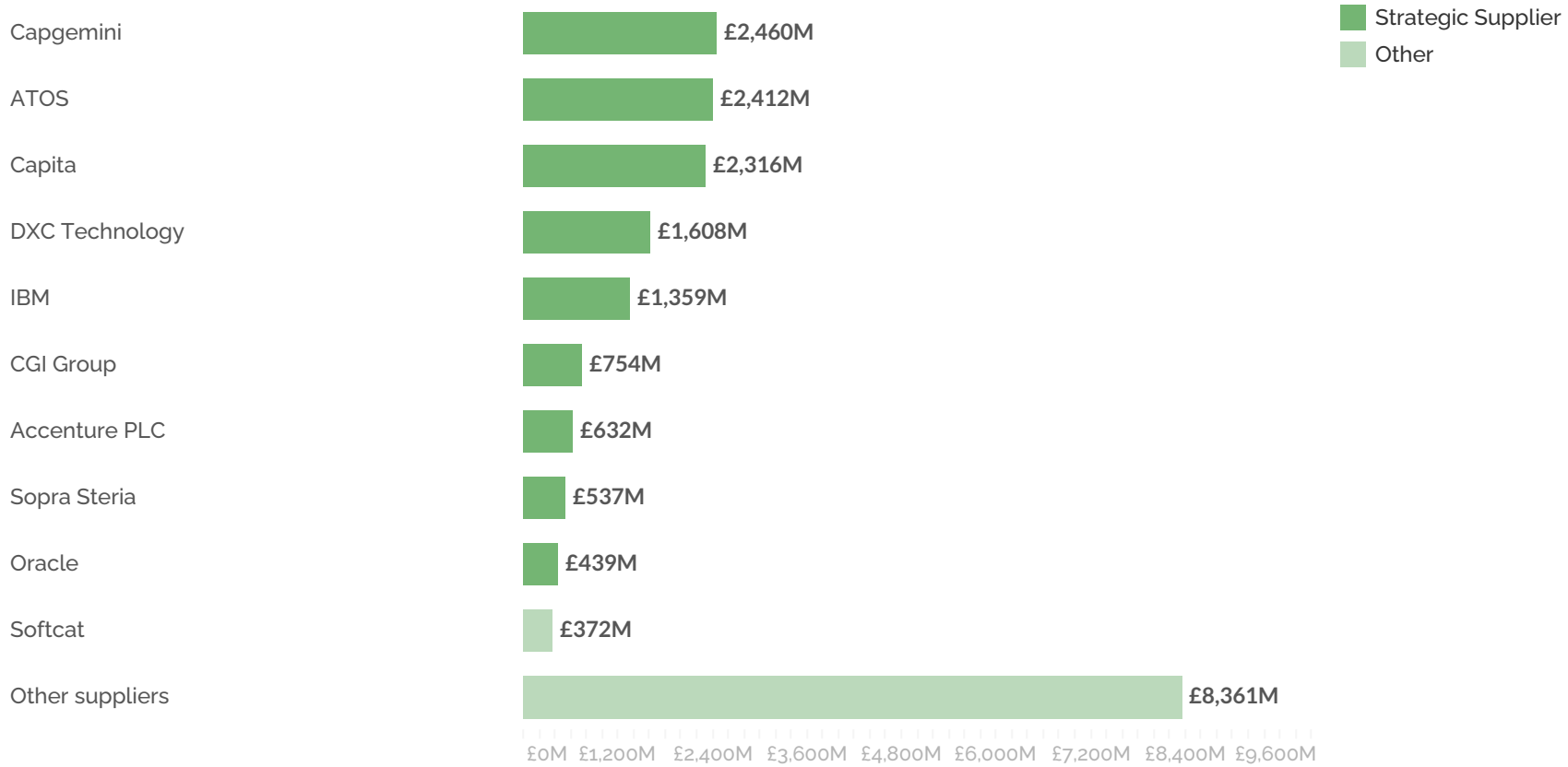
Of the top 3 departments by IT spend, the MoD is the most disaggregated

Distribution of type of suppliers for the top 3 departments by spend (£), 2016-2020



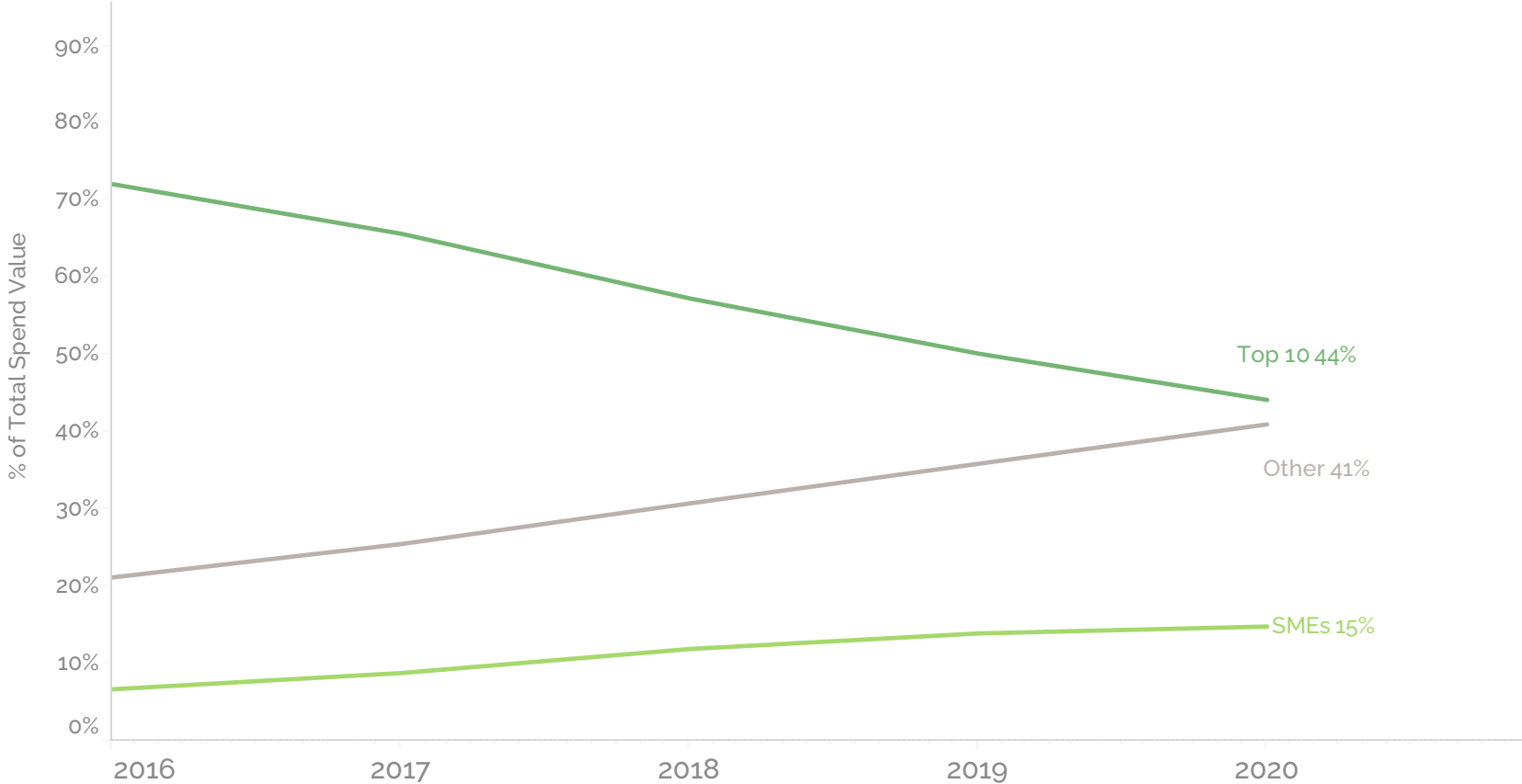
The top 10 suppliers earned over 60% of total Central Government IT spend, of which 9 are Strategic Suppliers. These SIs are a crucial route to market for SMEs

Top 10 vs. other tech suppliers by spend (£), 2016-2020



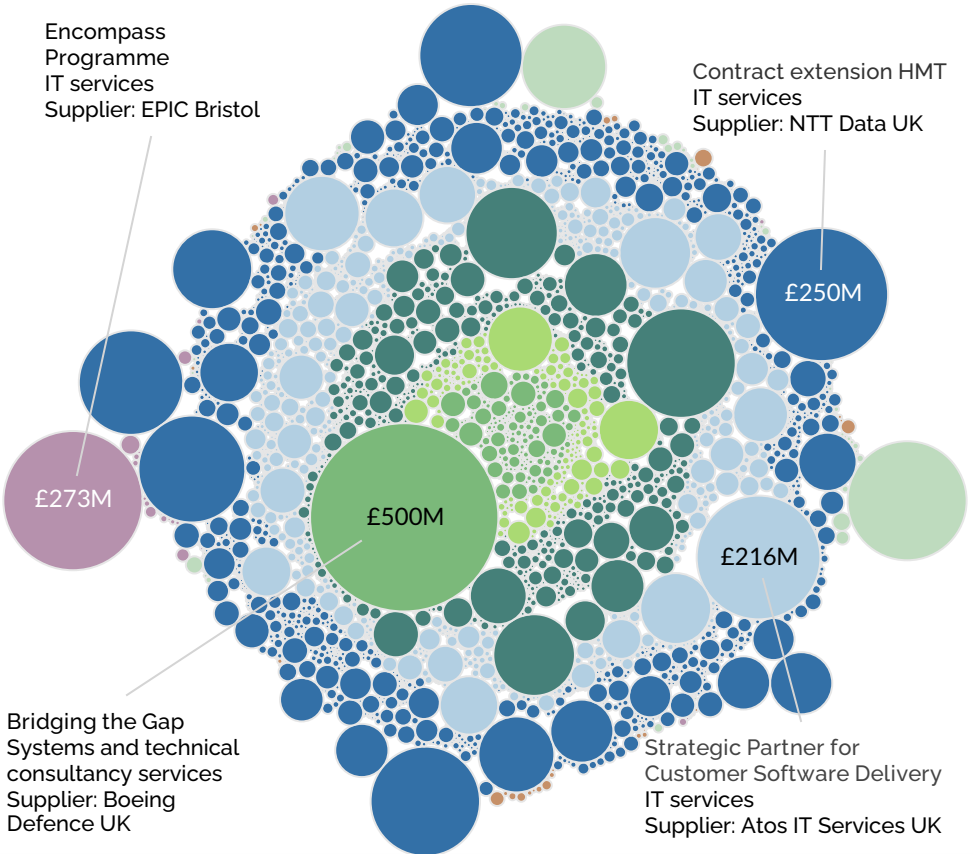
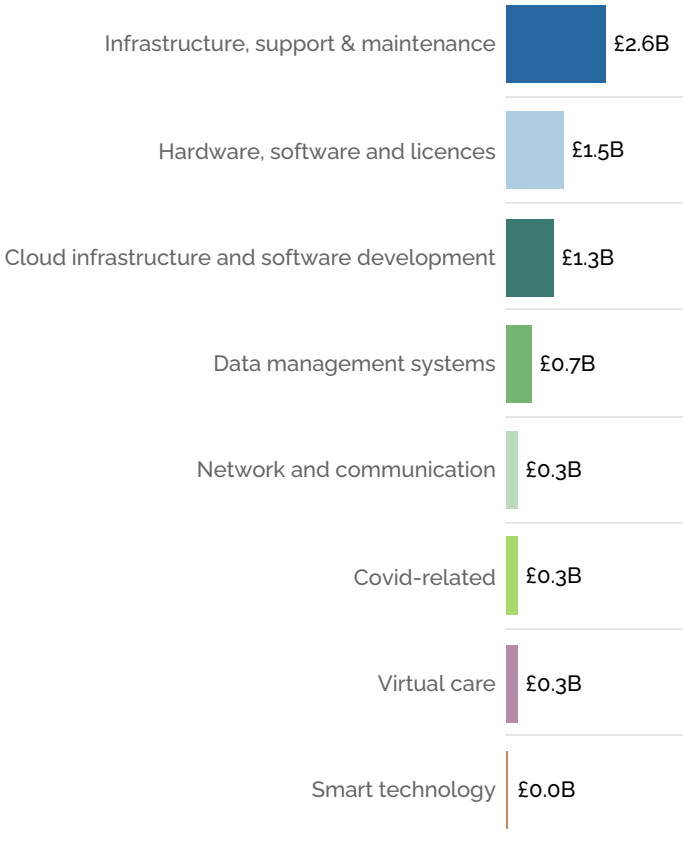
Contract disaggregation is real – and mid-cap IT companies have been the biggest beneficiaries

Market share of the top 10 suppliers vs. rest of market (IT spend/Total spend), 2016-2020



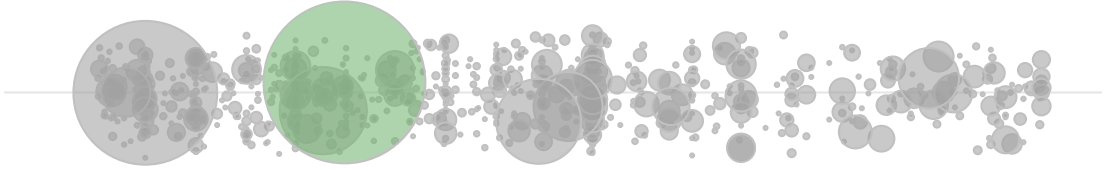
Infrastructure, Support and Maintenance contracts make up over 1/3 of all tech contracts awarded by value

Contracts awarded by area (£) and volume, 2016-2020



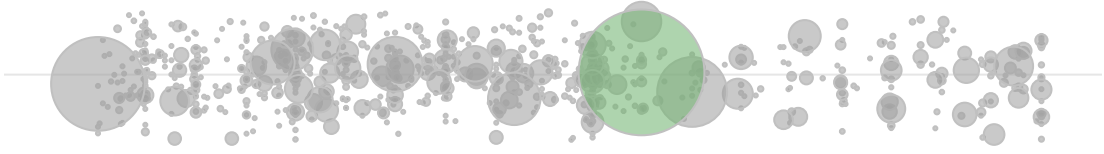
Over the next 18 months nearly 6,000 contracts in total worth £5Bn are due to expire – are you getting ready?

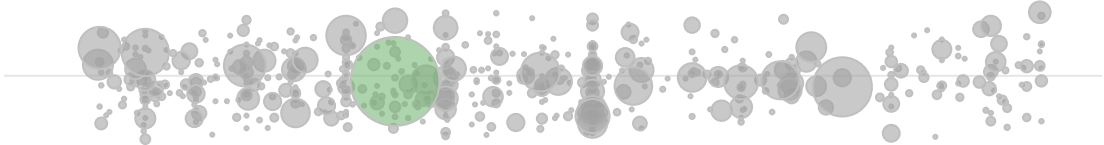

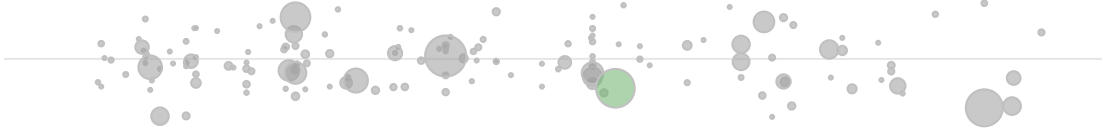

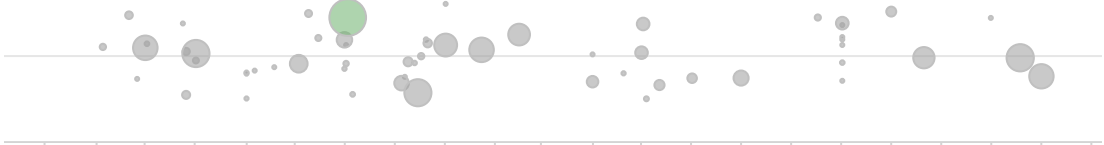

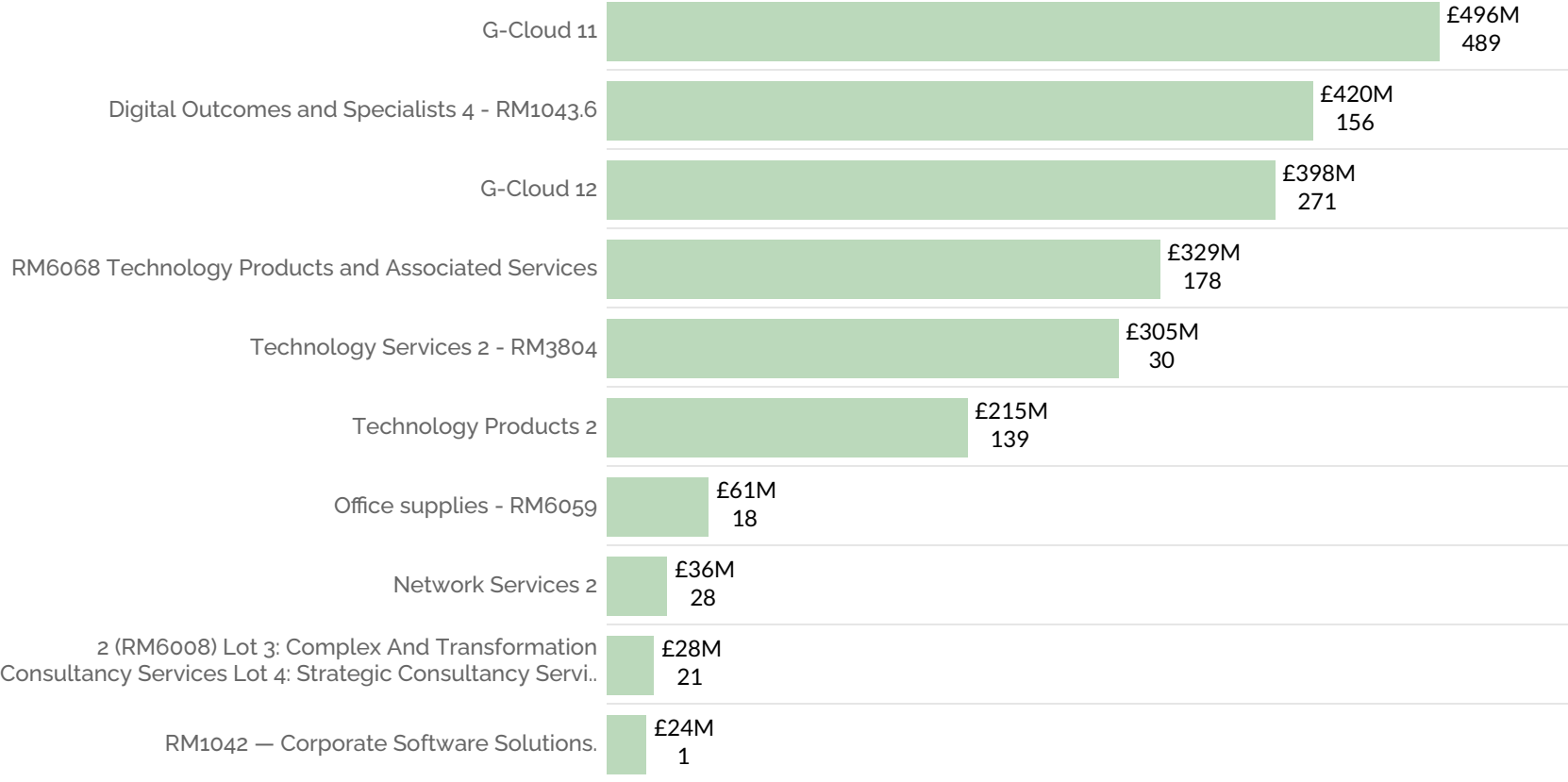

Key Findings

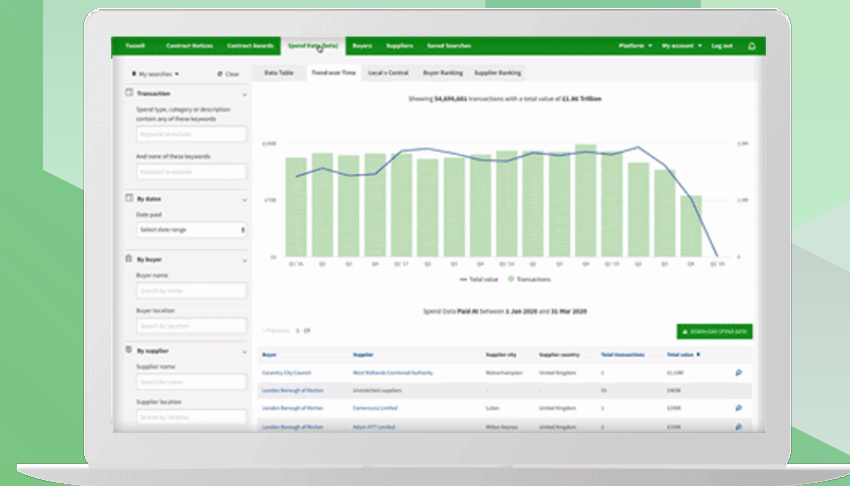
The pandemic accelerated the digitisation of public services and processes
