

Self-declaration on EU Timber Regulation No 995/2010 (EUTR)

This is to confirm that [each concerned mill^{*\)}](#) of [Stora Enso Paper Division](#) (in the following “Stora Enso”) complies with

Regulation (EU) No 995/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 October 2010 laying down the obligations of operators who place timber and timber products on the EU market (EUTR).

EUTR entered into force on 2nd December 2010 and is applied as from 3rd March 2013.

Each concerned mill^{*)} of Stora Enso acknowledges its responsibilities whenever it is in the role of an operator or trader as defined in EUTR. Operator means any natural or legal person that places timber and timber products on EU market. Trader means any natural or legal person who sells or buys timber or timber products already placed on the market. Operators shall exercise due diligence when placing timber or timber products on the market. Traders shall be able to identify the traders or operators who have supplied timber or timber products and to whom they have supplied timber and timber products.

All timber used in each concerned mill^{*)} of Stora Enso has been harvested and procured in compliance with the legislation applicable in the country, where the timber was harvested. All timber products consumed at the mill are derived from timber fulfilling the same qualification.

For EUTR risk assessment and Due Diligence each concerned mill^{*)} of Stora Enso applies third party certified FSC[®] Chain of Custody/Controlled Wood systems and/or PEFC[™] Chain of Custody/Due Diligence systems.

^{*)} Currently following mills of [Stora Enso Paper Division](#) are concerned by EUTR: [Anjala \(Finland\)](#), [Hylte \(Sweden\)](#), [Maxau \(Germany\)](#), [Nymölla \(Sweden\)](#). Langerbrugge (Belgium) mill is not concerned by EUTR due to their 100% recycled fibre input (which is exempted from EUTR requirements).
