Not all the items on the list will be found in your environment. Luck and location both influence your score. A Moment of Zen	Snap a photo of all team members balanced on one leg in a yoga pose next to a body of water.	Photo	10
A Wire Menagerie	A lark? A shark? A wiry pair for a makeshift ark? Create a couple of carefully contorted paperclip creatures and snap a photo of them!	Photo	10
Back in Black	Snap a photo of a teammate standing between two black cars parked side by side.	Photo	10
Barbershop	Find a red and white spinner outside a barbershop and snap a photo of a teammate standing under it.	Photo	40
Bigger is Better!	Snap a photo of someone carrying a giant drink such as a big gulp or extra-large soda or coffee.	Photo	10
Blockbuster Movie	Search for a movie theater and snap a photo of your team recreating one of the movie posters outside with the poster in the shot.	Photo	30
Bookworm	Head to a place where you could purchase the latest New York Times bestsellers. Then position the image of the book in a teammate's hands and snap a photo in front of the store's sign.	AR Photo	10
Cheer Line	Form a team high-five line on a busy street or at a transit depot. Snap a photo of your team giving passersby high-fives and cheering them on like at a sports event or parade.	Photo	30
Doppelganger	Find a stranger who looks just like a team member. Take a photo of your teammate with their doppelganger!	Photo	20
Double Inked!	Find two people who both have tattoo that are of the same thing such as two different butterflies or hearts for example. Take a photo of their tattoos together.	Photo	10
Dynamic Duo	Search for a tandem bicycle and snap a photo of two team members riding it.	Photo	30
Giant Flake!	Find or make a snowflake that is at least as big as someone's hand. Take a photo of the snowflake and someone's hand in the picture together for perspective.	Photo	20
Green Weaver	Create a wearable garment or accessory by knitting, weaving, or otherwise fashioning it out of plastic grocery bags. Then snap a photo of a teammate modeling it in front of a mannequin window display.	Photo	20
Happy Day to You!	Record a 5-second video of your team singing 'Happy Birthday' to a stranger who is celebrating a birthday today. Make sure the stranger's ID (or other proof) showing their birthday is clearly visible in the video.	Video	30
Literary Genius	Write a haiku about the city you're in and record a 5-second video of a teammate reciting it. A haiku is a poem whose first line has 5 syllables, second line has 7 syllables, and third line has 5 syllables.	Photo	20
Lost	Snap a photo of the team standing in front of a large public map while pretending to be lost.	Video	10
Make a Splash	Record a 5-second video of the team splashing in a public fountain. Water must be involved!	Video	30
Meter Reader	Search for a parking meter that has exactly 17 minutes remaining and snap a photo of a teammate pointing it out.	Photo	70
Name in Lights	Find a team member's first or last name on a theatre or cinema marquee and snap a photo of them with it. Enter their name in the caption space.	Photo	20

Name Pointing	Find something in print that has the name of at least one person in your team. Photo the person pointing to their name in print.	Photo	10
Need for Speed	Have a teammate engage in a footrace with a stranger between two points. Record a 5-second video mid-race.	Video	40
Now That's a Bubble	Snap a photo of a teammate blowing a bubble larger than their head – think soap bubbles or bubble gum. If you need something to make bubbles, get creative or borrow it from a stranger.	Photo	30
O My You're Strong	Find a stranger with bulging biceps and challenge them to an arm wrestling match. Snap a photo of the stranger winning.	Photo	20
Out of State	Snap a picture of a far-away license plate from another state or province with a team member in the photo.	Photo	10
Parkour	Select 3 team members to jump over an object at least waist height. Snap a photo mid-jump with all teammates' feet in the air at the same time.	Photo	30
Personification	Find a street sign with the same name as a teammate. Snap a photo of the team member standing next to the sign.	Photo	20
Photobomb	Search for another team and snap a photo of a teammate photobombing them as they complete a challenge.	Photo	50
Photo Shoot	Take a picture of a stranger taking a picture of you.	Photo	10
Reach for the Sky	Find someone who is willing to take picture of your entire team showing how far they can jump off the ground and touch the sky! Everyone must have their hands in the air and feet off the ground in order to successfully complete this challenge. You must also have the sky in the background.	Photo	30
Sad Songs Say...	Write an original country song and perform a free concert in a public area for all to see. Record a 5-second video of your team's debut song!	Video	30
Safety First	Locate a construction site and borrow 3 pieces of personal protective equipment from one of the workers. Then snap a photo of a teammate wearing the equipment alongside the worker.	Photo	20
Scavenger Hunt	Find a sign with the word "Scavenger" or "Hunt" in it and take a photo of your entire team pointing to the word and holding up their cell phones.	Photo	10
Small World	Ideas and news come from around the world. Find a printed newspaper from another country and snap a photo of a teammate holding it.	Photo	10
Thank You	Ask a stranger whose speaks another language to teach your team how to say 'thank you' in their native tongue. Record a 5-second video of your team and the stranger saying 'thank you' all together!	Video	30
Up in the Air	Look to the skies and take a photo of an airplane flying overhead. Make sure you zoom in to clearly show the airplane in the photo.	Photo	20
We Are the Champions	Snap a photo of a teammate doing the Heisman pose under the goalpost in the end zone of a local football field.	Photo	30
Well Connected	Collect 10 unique business cards and snap a photo with at least one team member displaying the cards.	Photo	20
What a Year	Obtain a coin of any denomination from 1999 and snap a photo of it with the year clearly visible.	Photo	10
Yarr Pirates	Construct a pirate hat made of newspaper. Then snap a photo of a teammate wearing it while standing near a (real or fake) parrot or ship.	Photo	20
