Dear friends of Province Lighting,

A NEW CHAPTER BEGINS FOR PROVINCE LIGHTING

We are writing to share a big – and bittersweet – announcement that our founder, Jurgen Chemelli, together with wife Juliet, have decided to retire and step down from executive roles at Province Lighting after 34 years of service to the company.

This is no doubt big news for Province Lighting, and indeed the SA lighting market more generally. Jurgen and Juliet have achieved so much with Province Lighting over the last three and a half decades and, having successfully concluded a detailed succession plan and with Province Lighting in a strong market and financial position, feels the time is now right to hand over the reins and step back from an operational role.

Humble beginnings

Jurgen co-founded Province Lighting in 1987, six years after starting his career in lighting with Austrian lighting specialist Zumtobel. 34 years later, Jurgen and his partners have built Province Lighting into the leading supplier of commercial, industrial, and architectural lighting and building automation solutions provider in Southern Africa. Today Province Lighting has over 150 employees across offices all over South Africa as well as Namibia, Kenya, Mauritius, and representation in Nigeria as well as a state-of-the-art production facility in Johannesburg manufacturing tailor-made luminaires for customers.

New era, same team

While Jurgen's retirement will no doubt see a change in the 'face' of Province Lighting, he must be commended for building a strong sales and management team which has allowed him to retire without any disruptions to the business.

For the last three years, Jurgen has been focused on new markets and internal operations of Province Lighting, having already handed over most client and supplier relationships to **Dereck Abbey** (*Director: Western Cape, KZN, and Namibia*); **Kevin Murphy** (*Director: Gauteng and Eastern Cape*); and **Jannie Malan** (*Director: Africa*). Dereck, Kevin and Jannie are material shareholders and partners in the business, and between them have been with Province Lighting for over 50 years, so their institutional knowledge of the business, customers, suppliers and markets will allow seamless continuity following Jurgen's retirement. We are fortunate to have a deep pool of management skills and lighting experience within the group, and Dereck, Jannie and

The succession planning already implemented has allowed senior staff in the company to take on more responsibility and grow professionally.

In addition, being part of the Rubicon Group creates significant opportunities for the business to grow and leverage off complementary offerings. The relationship has already borne fruit in new and existing markets such as Eastern Cape, KZN, Namibia and Africa, whilst also taking advantage of group synergies and economies of scale, including benefiting from strong and cost-effective functional and back office support services. Province Lighting today is in a very strong position to execute on our number one objective: to deliver world-class, innovative, and tailor-made solutions and service to our valued customers.
