Is SleepWeaver Prevent Ideal for Sleep Labs?

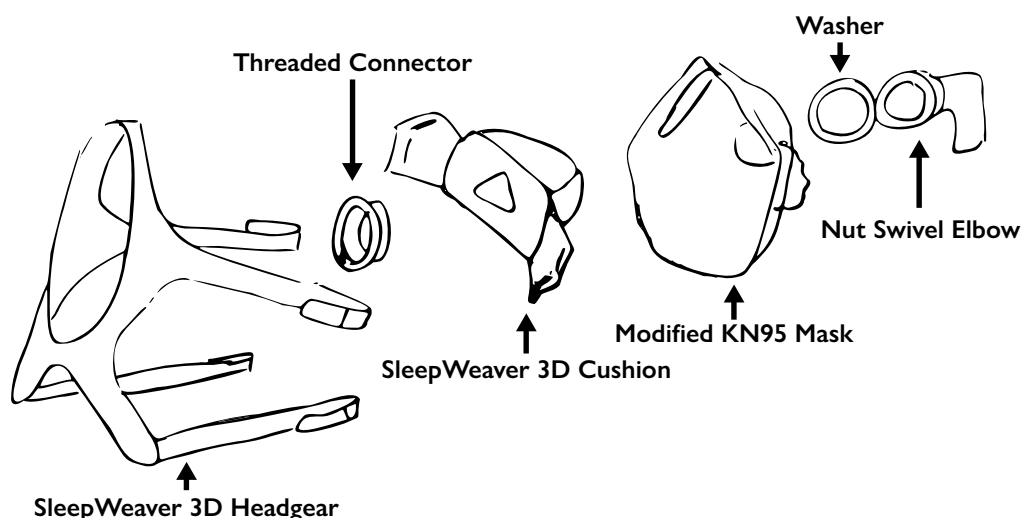
Sleep labs across the United States have been closed for months and are struggling to reopen under the current conditions. This means many patients are not receiving the diagnosis and therapy that they desperately need to sleep well. In areas where reopening is possible or telemedicine options are available, there are still many hurdles for labs to overcome.

The CDC and American Academy of Sleep Medicine (AASM) have cautioned about the possible transmission of COVID-19 during aerosol-generating procedures such as PAP therapy. Guidance from the AASM advocates use of appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) for staff administering PAP therapy. Meanwhile, patients have a limited number of PPE options when using PAP therapy—both in the lab and at home.

SleepWeaver® Prevent is designed to provide an additional level of isolation for PAP/NIV patients with known or suspected respiratory infections. This new mask uses an modified KN95 Mask to filter exhaled air from Circadian's SleepWeaver 3D PAP Mask.
