

Meetup Week COVID 19 Safety Measures

Registrants must agree to our terms and conditions, which include our on-site COVID-19 safety protocols. Attendees must provide proof they are fully vaccinated, or have a negative COVID-19 test completed no more than 24 hours before the start of the live event.

In order to confirm your registration and be accepted to attend our live event, you must send a copy of your vaccination card, other official proof that you are fully vaccinated, or proof of a negative COVID test completed no more than 24 hours prior to the event. Registrants will also be required to sign a confirmation that their proof of vaccination or test result is theirs and is accurate.

We ensure that we follow, or in most cases exceed, the CDC guidelines at all times. Attendees will complete a screening survey and a touchless temperature check as they enter the venue, even if they are vaccinated. These simple screens are extremely effective, and only further help ensure the protection and safety of our guests and staff. We strongly encourage that everyone practices social distancing of at least 6 feet, wears a mask, and sanitizes as necessary. DSS will provide sanitation stations throughout the venue. We require that you come to the event with a face mask properly covered over the nose. If there is a need for additional face masks, we will be happy to provide one upon request.

Our safety protocols are in place to ensure we are providing the safest possible environment. We want our attendees to feel safe and most importantly, that we take all measures seriously. As the situation evolves, so will our approach to keeping our attendees and staff safe. We thank you for your patience and flexibility as we manage this and ask that you check back here for updates.
