Also the industry expertise of teachers motivated students to make good progress and develop the skills they need in the workplace.


The three campuses were assessed by a team of inspectors in March 2018.

# ALABOUT The qualifications can take you up to the same level as a degree... and you get paid too!

Apprenticeships are simple. You start working straight away and study towards a qualification on-the-job. An assessor will visit you in your workplace to support you with training; and for some qualifications you may need to also come into college.

Apprenticeships are great if you want to get straight into the workplace and start earning some money while you build up the qualifications you need for your career. If your employer supports you it's possible to train to the highest degree-level qualifications through apprenticeships.

And that means they're not just for young new recruits. For example you might study Level 2 and 3 courses with us before hooking up with an employer and doing a Level 4 or 5 apprenticeship.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SCHOOL LEAVERS:

To start an apprenticeship you need to find a company that's prepared to employ you as an apprentice. This might not always be possible by the start of term after you have finished your GCSEs.

It is a legal requirement to be in full time education, employment or training before the age of 18, so our advice is to apply for a full time course that is related to the apprenticeship you want to do.

On your application form tick the box that asks you if you are interested in an apprenticeship. We will try to match you to a vacancy before the start of term in College, but if that's not possible you will still have an offer of a College place to fall back on in September.

Don't worry, if you still want to be an apprentice you can, still attend special tutorials to help you find a vacancy, work on your applications and prepare you for interviews. Our aim will be to find you an apprenticeship while you study.



# The Policing College is the first of its kind in the UK. It offers an exciting opportunity to train for vital roles with Lincolnshire Police and its strategic partner, G4S.

The College has been designed to train school leavers to prepare them for apprenticeships and jobs in police support roles and to provide a pathway for students to study a Professional Policing Degree and join up as police officers.

All students will spend a significant amount of time in police environments, training with officers and hearing from expert guest speakers from the Police and G4S.

The Study Programme will also have a focus on physical fitness, health and well-being, resilience, problem solving and leadership. Students will continue English and Maths studies to improve their literacy and numeracy.

# MADE IN Gainsborough

Made in Gainsborough is a unique opportunity to build a career in engineering in Gainsborough through an apprenticeship with some of the town's best-known firms.

Our Made in Gainsborough partners; AMP Rose, Eminox, Wefco, Regal, Trepko, Clean Tech, A Schulman and Hooton Engineering are all looking for school-leaver and adult apprentices to work for them.

These firms worked with Gainsborough College to build this new Centre of Excellence as they were finding it difficult to fill their job vacancies with highly skilled local people.

Our apprentices will earn money from day one and successful candidates, who complete their two to three year Level 3 apprenticeship, will secure a long-term career in engineering.

# **COURSE DETAIL:**

In year one apprentices will develop their general engineering knowledge, predominantly at Gainsborough College in an environment that reflects real-life industry settings.

One day a week will be spent with their employer, either at College or in the workplace. This year is focused on getting apprentices career-ready, so they can safely transition into their company workshops.



In year two the model reverses and apprentices spend four days a week with their engineering employer and one-day a week at College.
