

COVID-19 Management Plan

- All arrangements are in line with current UK Government guidance and Site Operating Procedures published by the Construction Leadership Council
- UK Government position since the start of the pandemic has been that where suitable measures can be implemented, construction sites in England should remain operational
- The Plan for the Rookery project includes:
 - Transport to site has been re-arranged to ensure that only personnel who are sharing accommodation are travelling together in “work bubbles”
 - All persons arriving at site are subject to temperature screening and “misting booths” which decontaminate workers
 - Workforce start, finish and break times are staggered to avoid large groups
 - Additional units have been installed in the welfare area (canteen, locker rooms & offices) to provide extra space and enable social distancing.
 - Social distancing enforced by on-site “COVID Marshals” in all social areas.
 - Additional handwashing facilities and sanitiser. Plus all facilities including offices have additional cleaning / disinfection
 - Covid-19 testing continue to be available to all on-site construction personnel

Note: Skilled staff involved in construction of waste management facilities are exempt from 14 day quarantine for arrivals into UK from overseas
