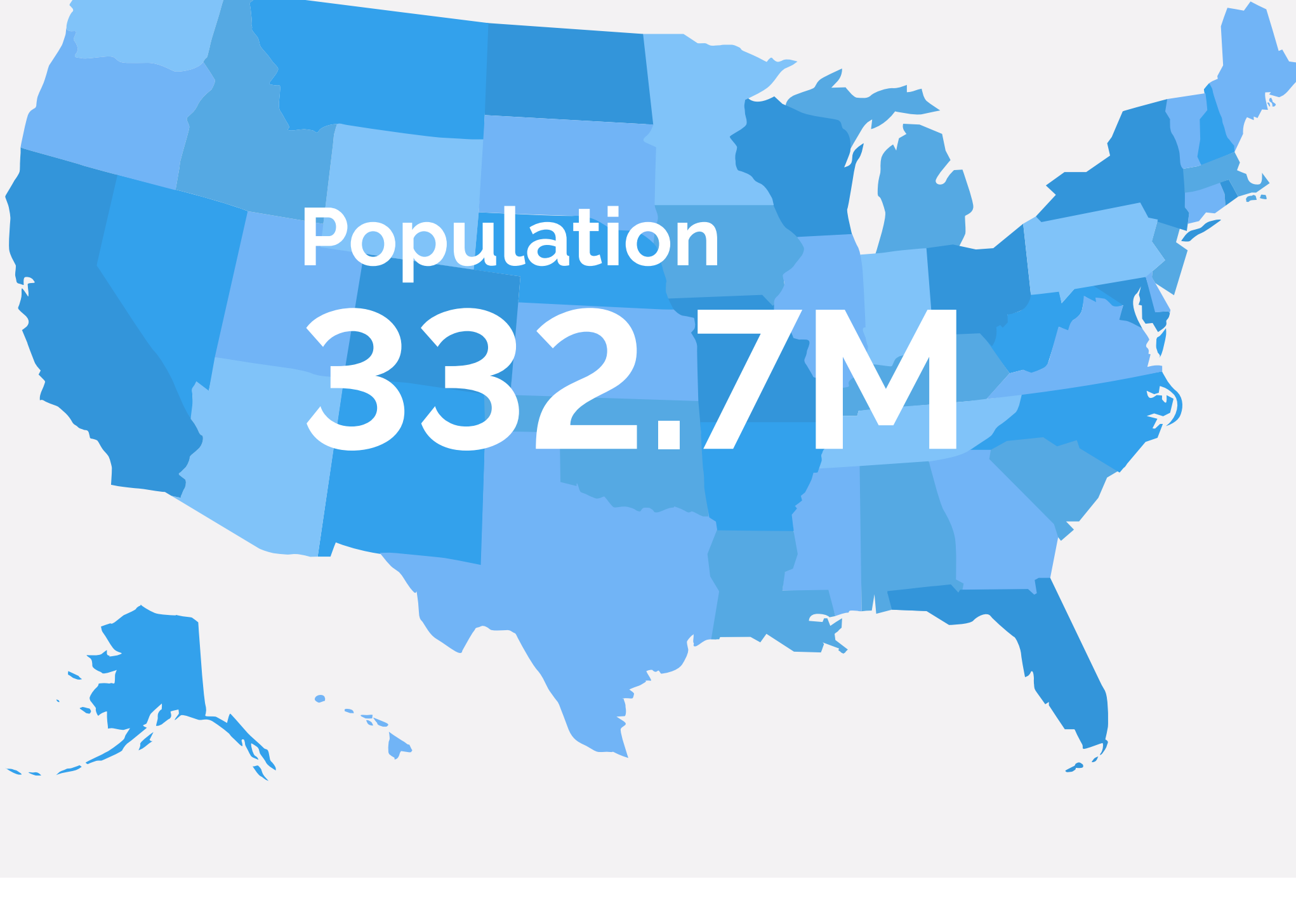
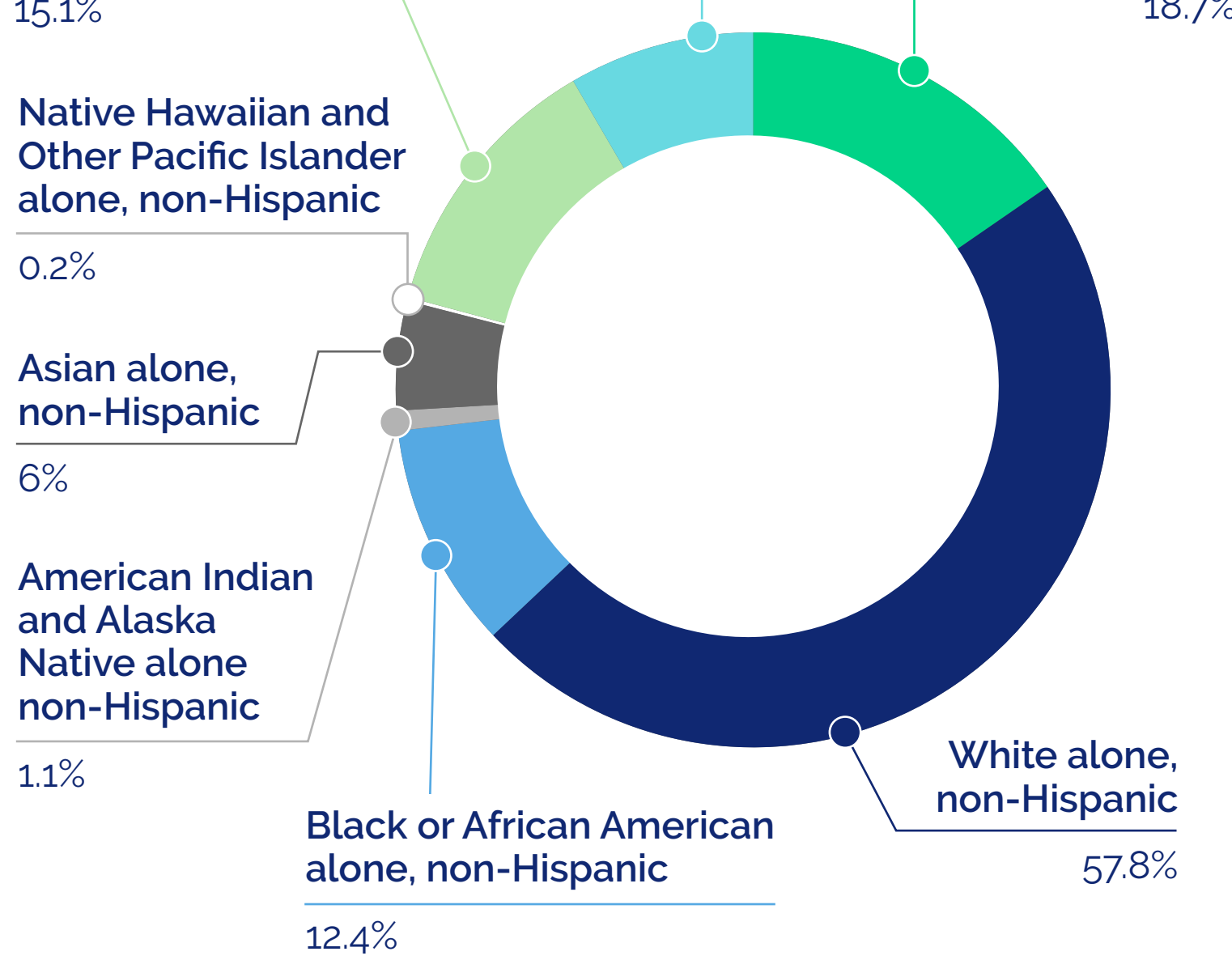

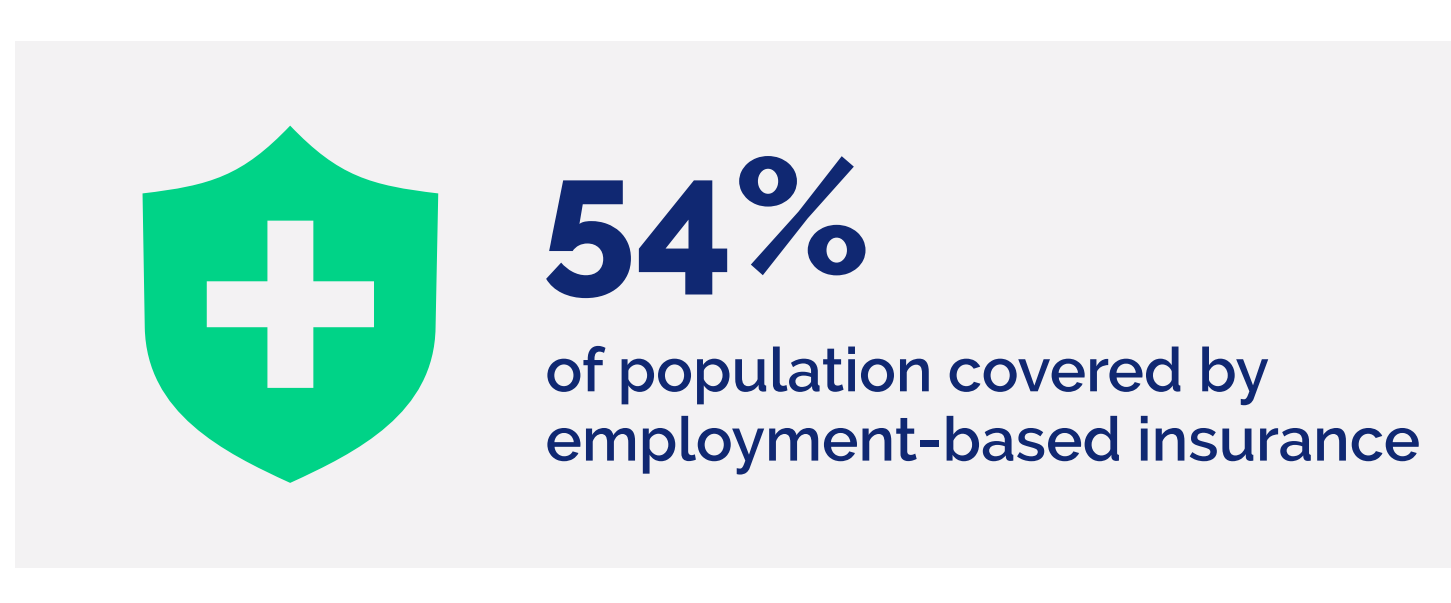
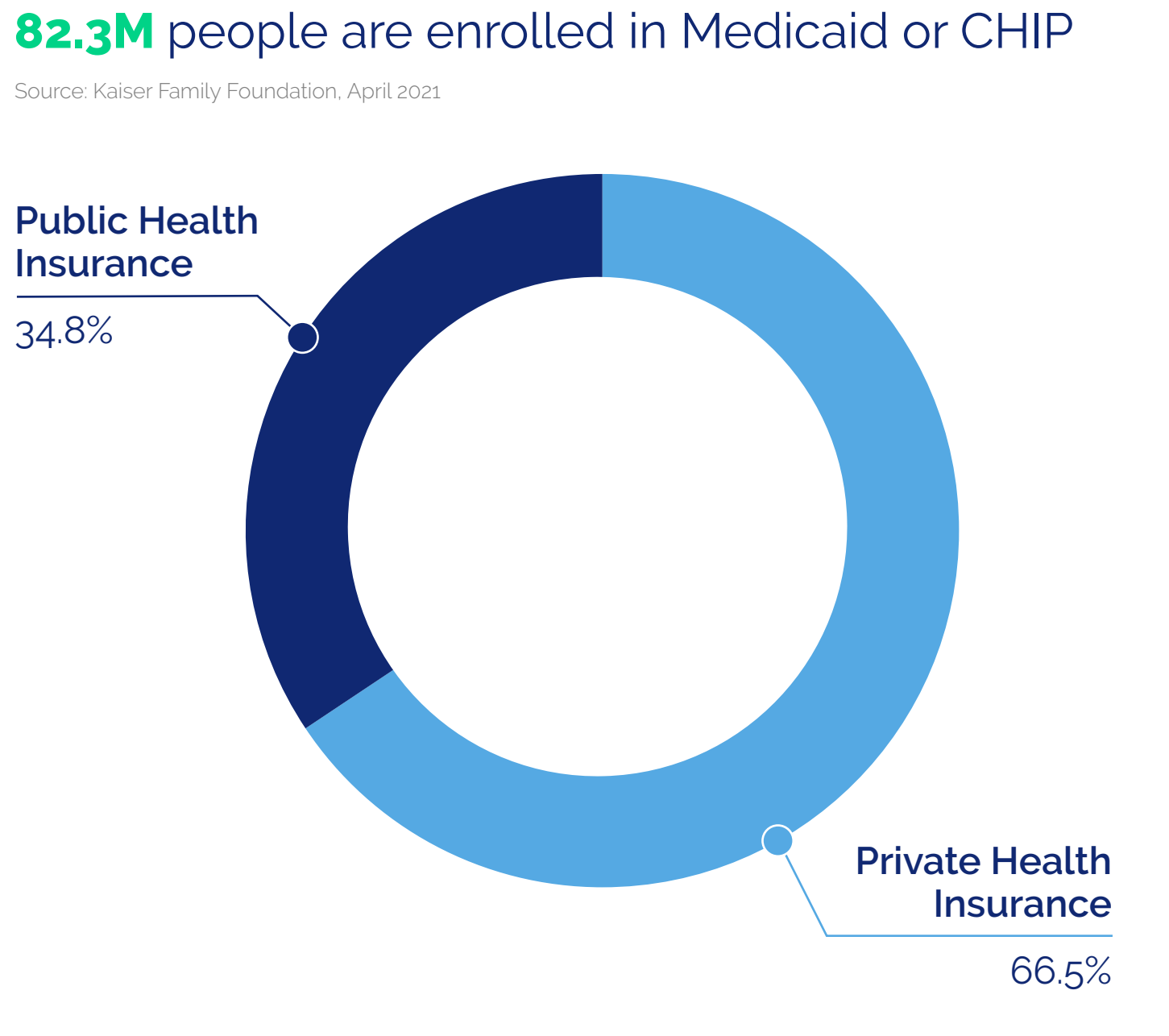
Health Insurance

Education

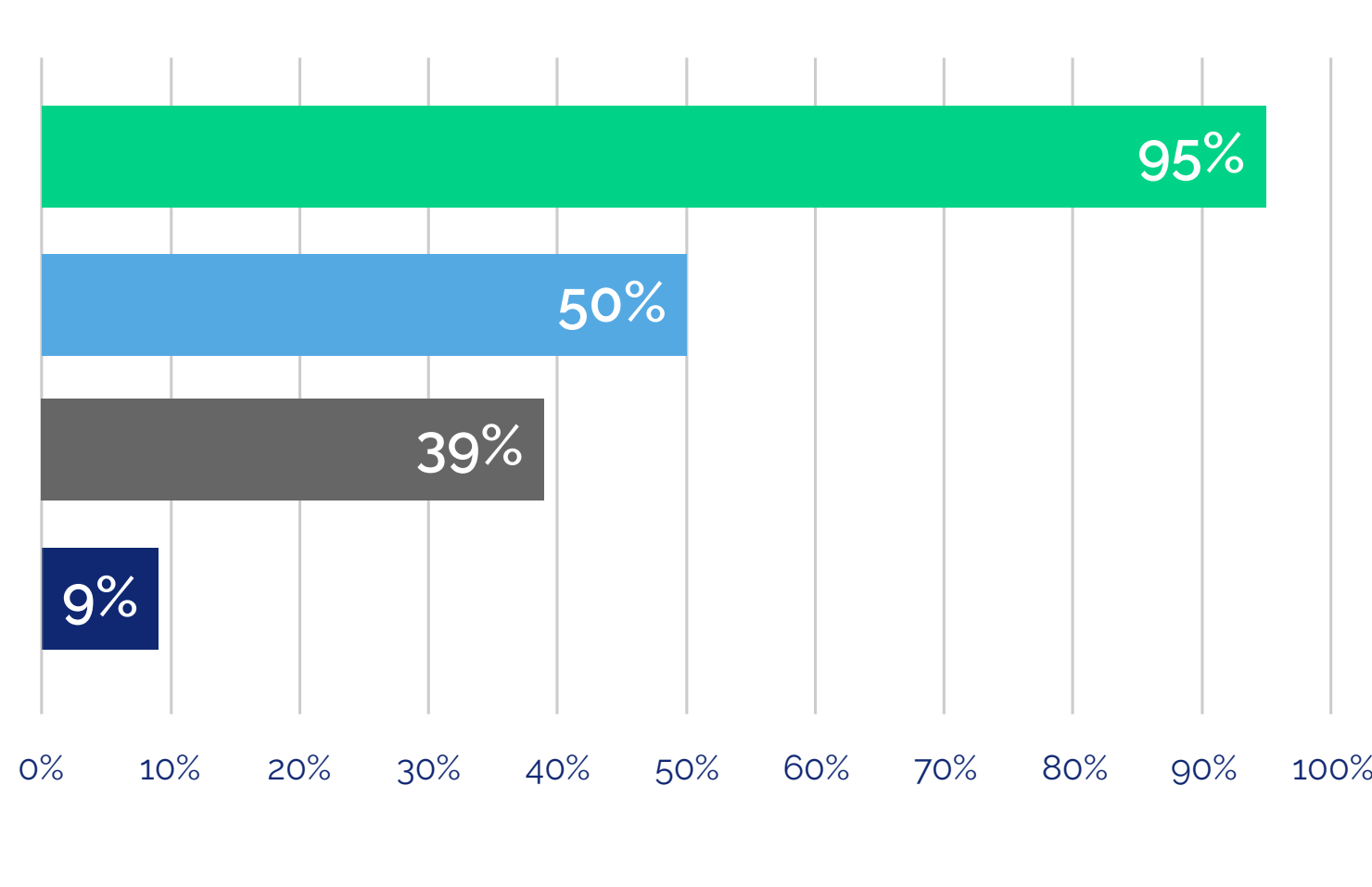
More than **one third** of the population has a bachelor's degree, but only **25%** of Black Americans and **19%** of Hispanic Americans have a bachelor's degree.

Educational Attainment Among 25- to 29-year-olds

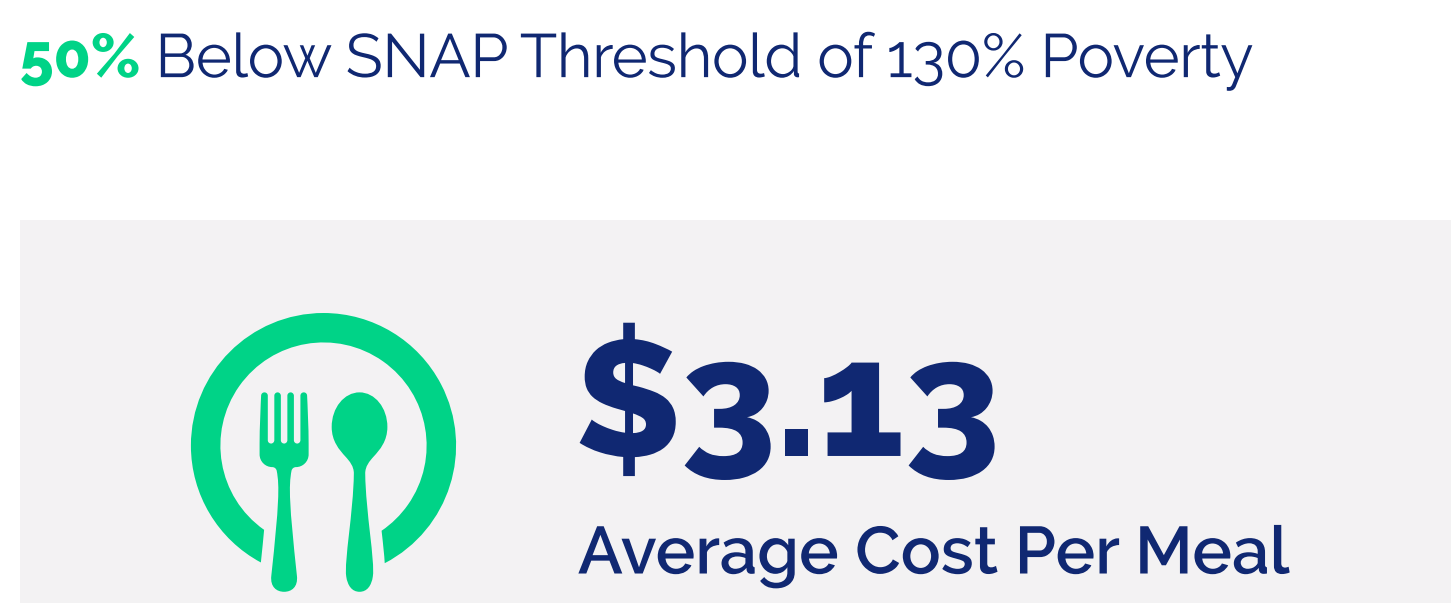

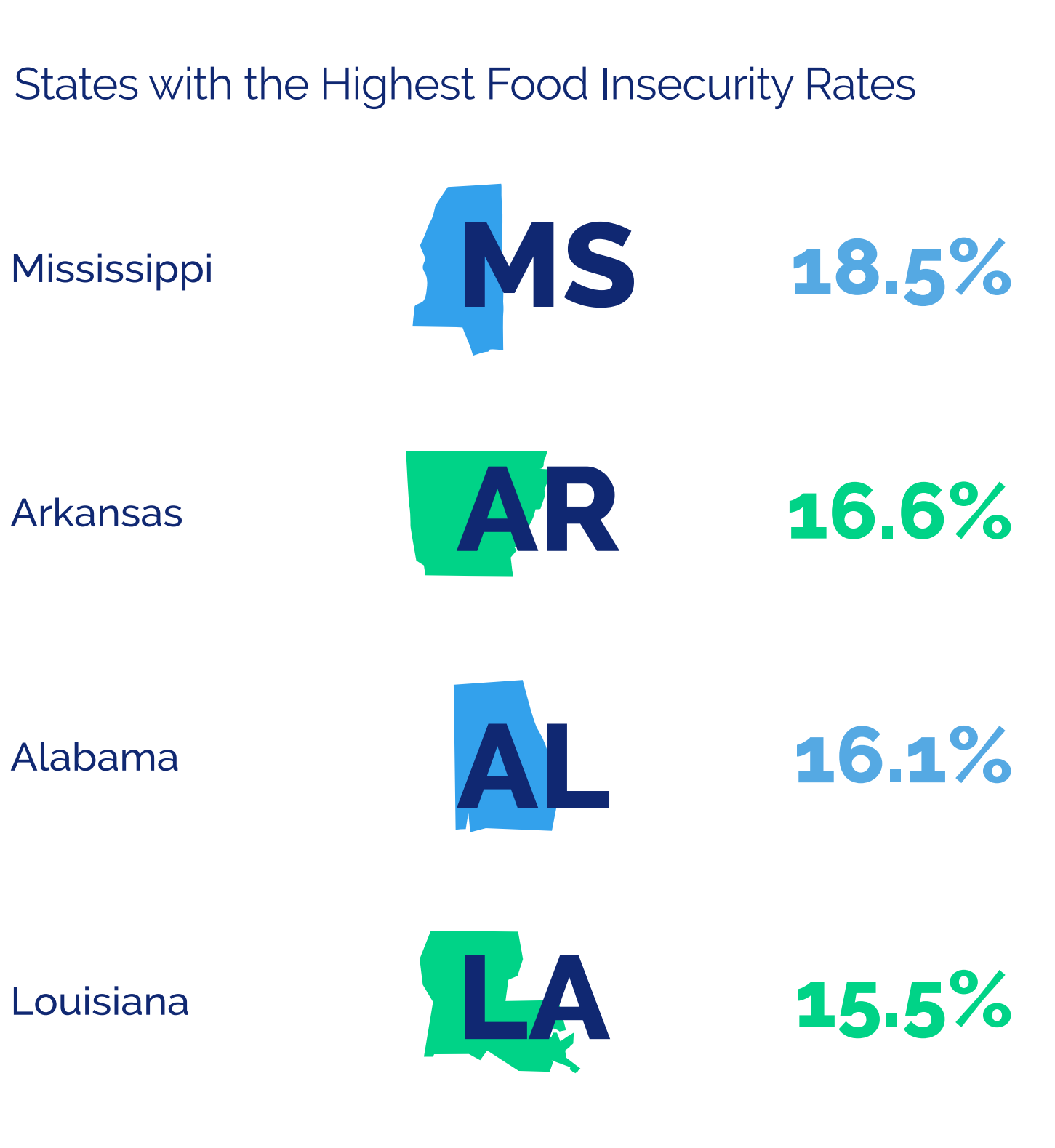
Food

States with the Highest Food Insecurity Rates



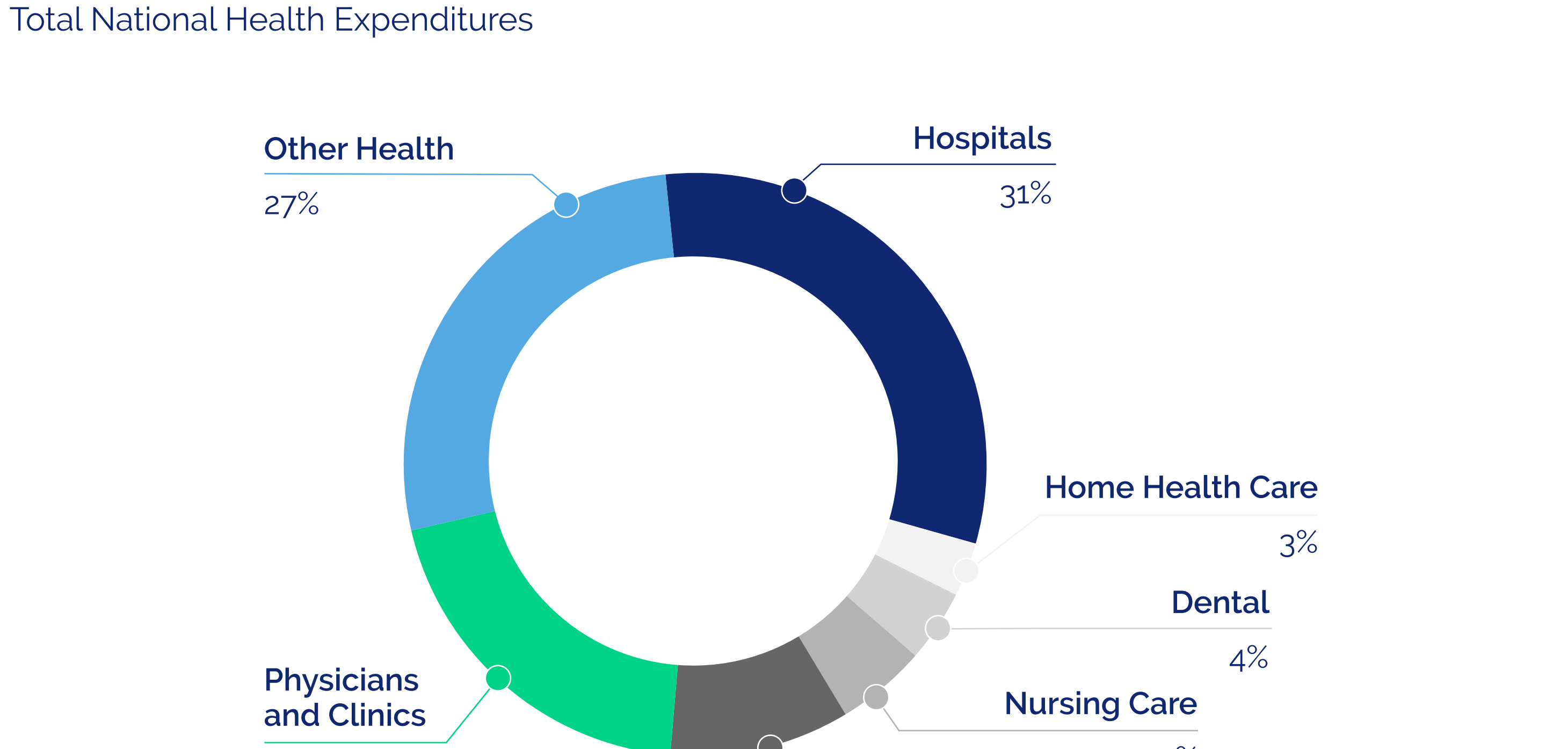

Healthcare Expenditures



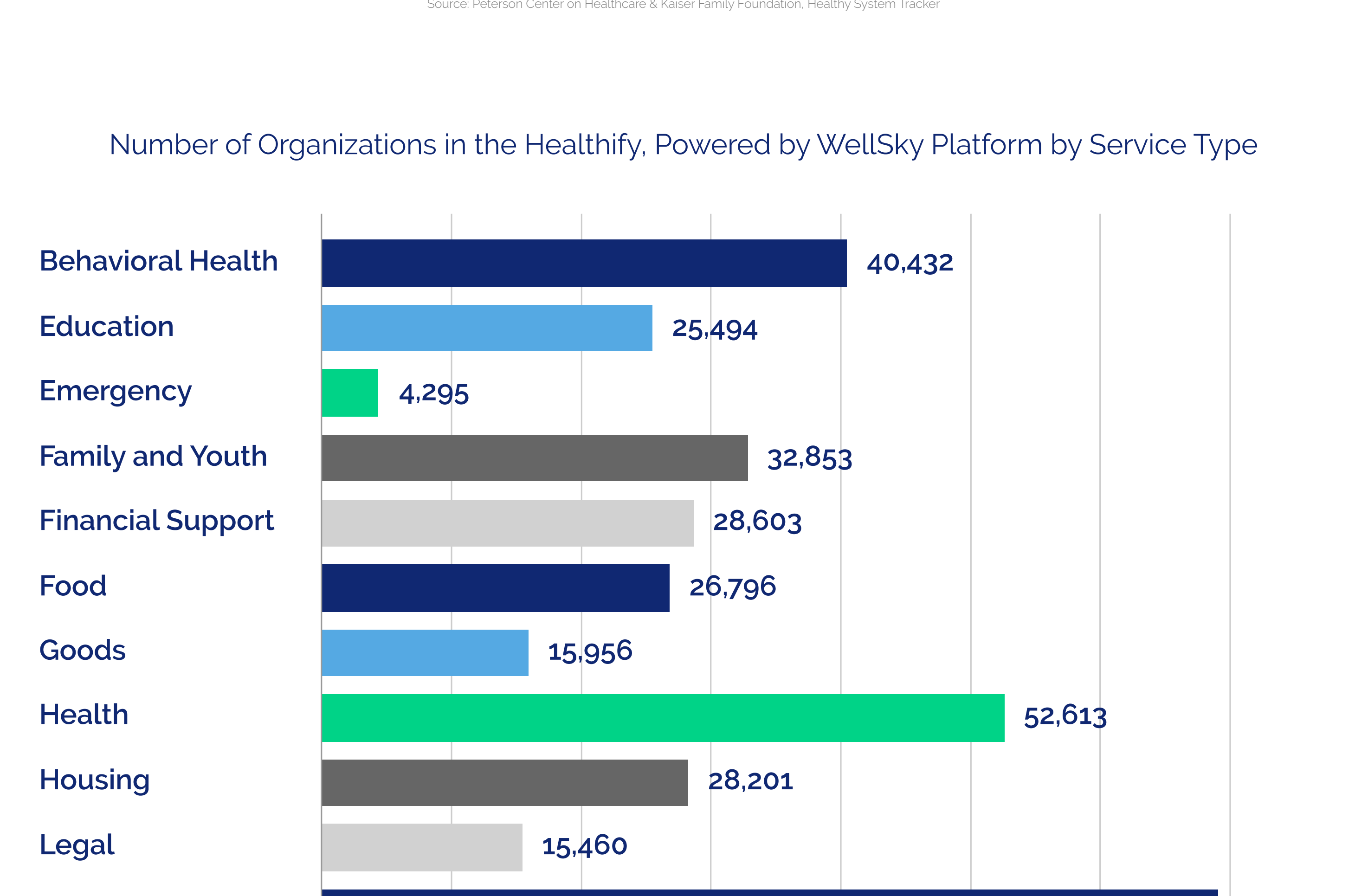

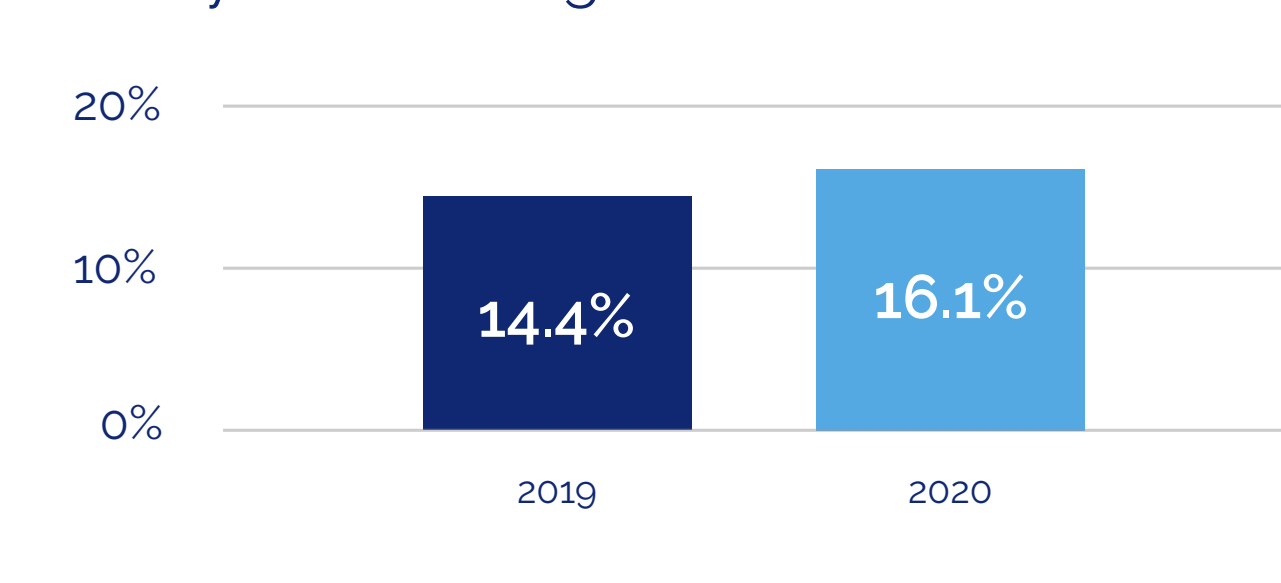

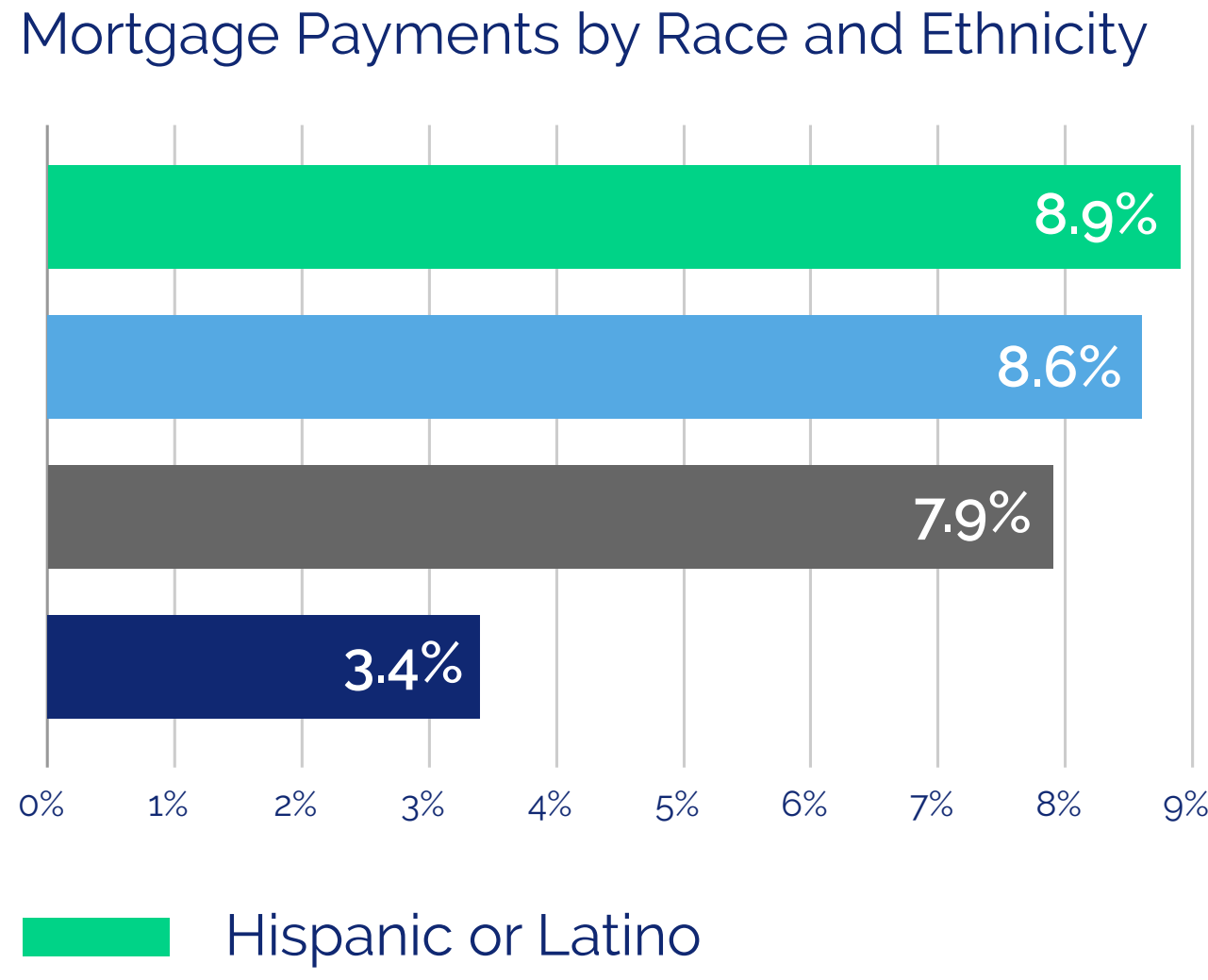

Percentage of Homeowners Behind on Mortgage Payments by Race and Ethnicity

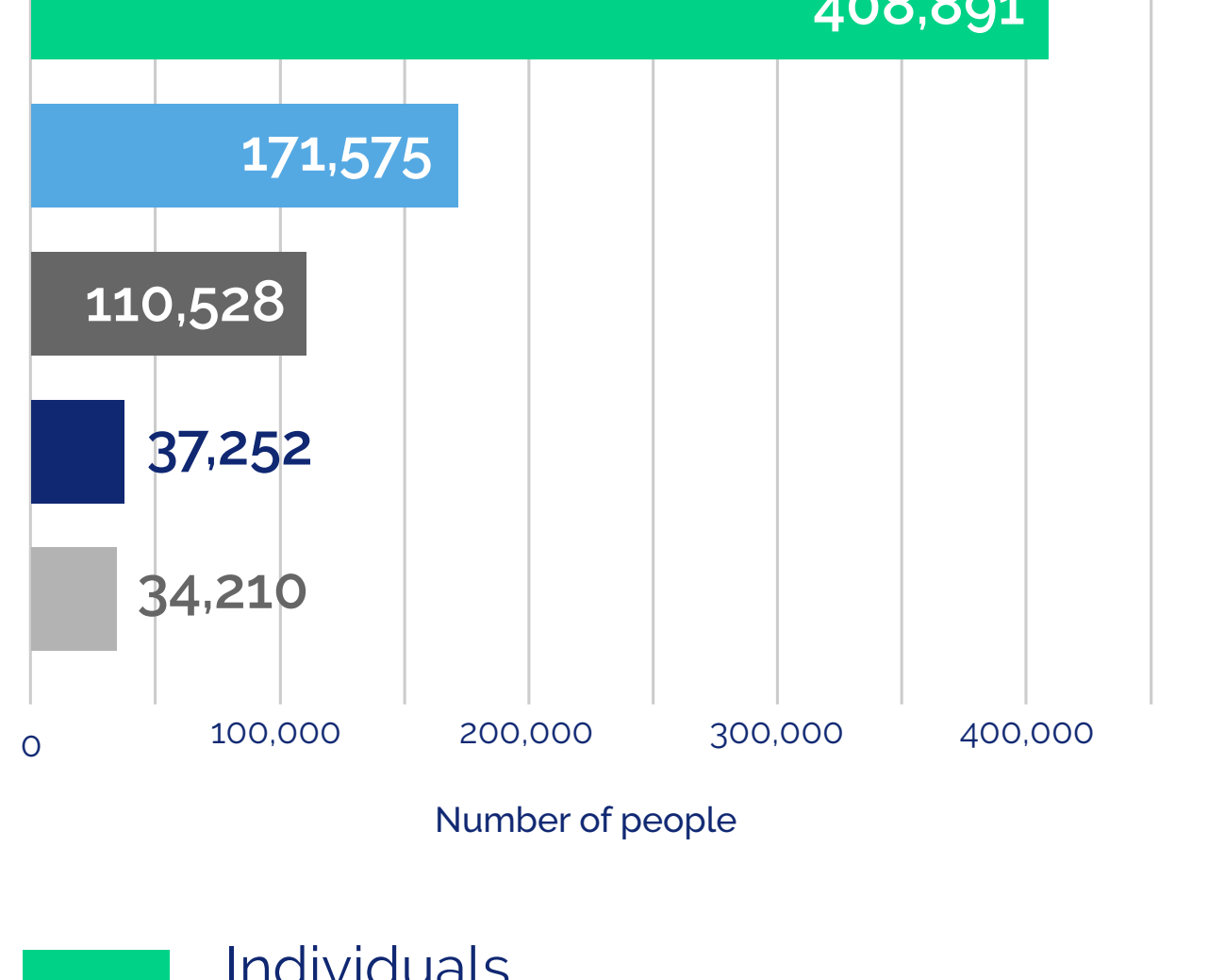

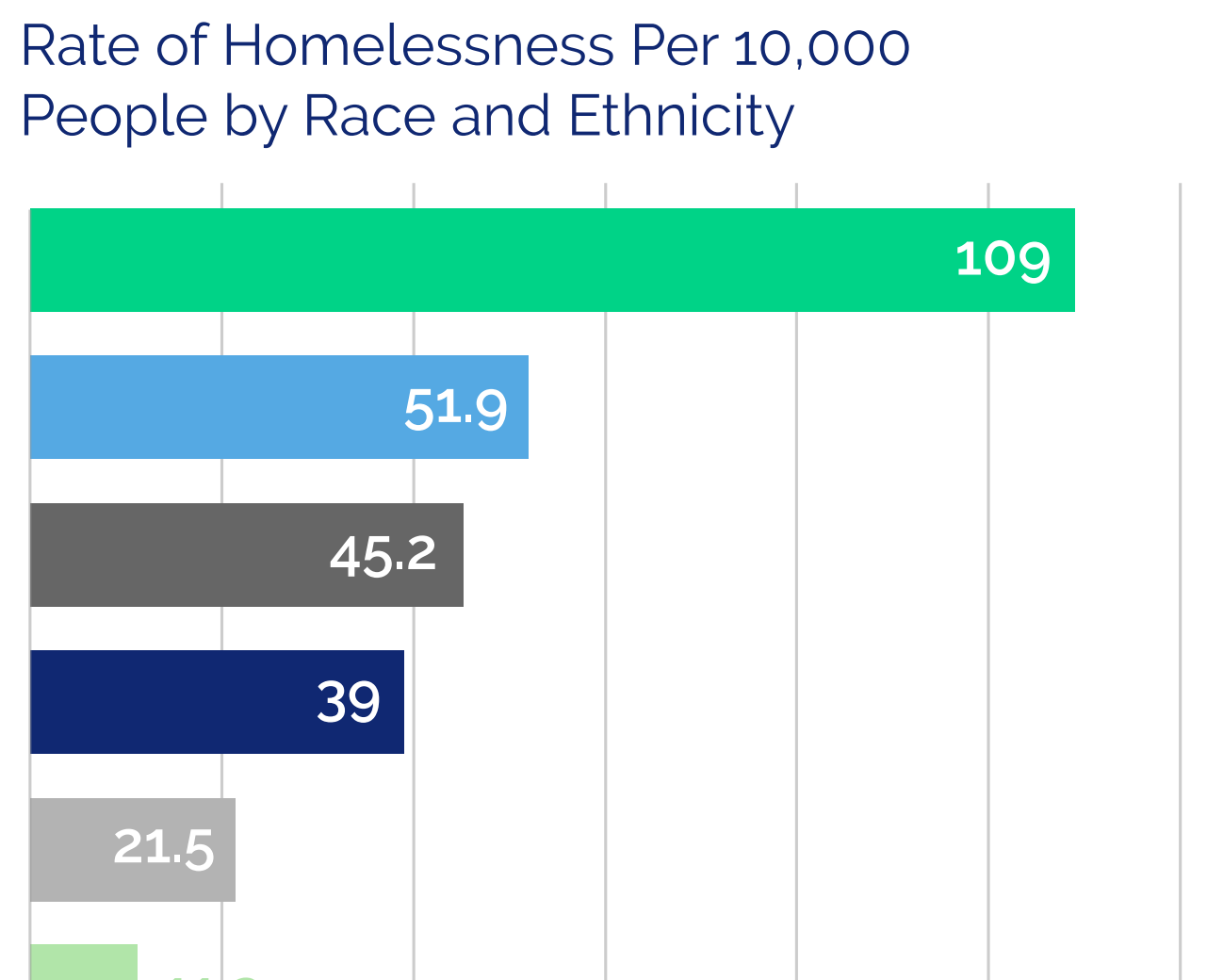
