SPRING 2022 SYLLABUS ADDENDUM FOR ALL CLASSES WITH SCHEDULED IN-PERSON SESSIONS ON CAMPUS

On FEBRUARY 1, Regis College will return to our previously scheduled IN PERSON classes.

In order to return to campus, all students, staff and faculty must be in compliance with the CoVerified protocol which requires a negative test result for COVID-19, unless they have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 90 days, and proof of this test has been uploaded into CoVerified (see details <u>here</u>).

All students are expected to attend class in person if that is the modality through which it is being offered. The only permitted exception is a documented excused absence.

Regis recognizes that students who have tested positive for COVID-19 or who have been advised by our Health Services to isolate or quarantine may not be able to attend classes in person for some period of time. To enable these students to make academic progress, the instructor may offer a ZOOM link to an individual student ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS so that they can have access to the class that is being taught in person while they are excused.

STUDENTS MAY NOT SHARE ZOOM LINKS WITH OTHER CLASSMATES UNLESS SPECIFICALLY PERMITTED TO DO SO BY THE INSTRUCTOR. Students who use a Zoom link to attend a class when not provided that link by the instructor may, at the instructor's discretion, be marked as absent for that class.

If a student is experiencing symptoms, they should input them into CoVerified, which will trigger outreach to them by Health Services, who can register an excused absence. Health Services, in concert with advising, will work as quickly as possible to provide these notifications on the day in which they are notified of the student's specific need for excused absence. STUDENTS SHOULD CONTACT THEIR INSTRUCTOR IN ORDER TO INFORM THEM THAT THEY ARE AWATING GUIDANCE FROM HEALTH SERVICES.

All students are required per campus guidelines to mask and to comply with the Campus Code of Conduct, including all provisions related to COVID protocols.
