

Give your youngest writers a head start in writing success.

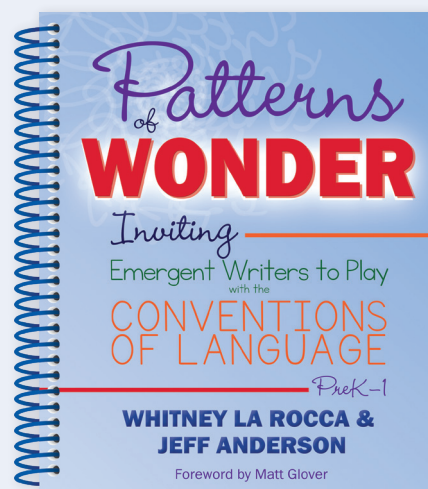
