ACCU's solid earnings in 2018 and strong capital levels enabled us to invest in improved digital capabilities and initiatives that allowed us to continue to deepen member relationships. ACCU reported net income of \$3.7 million, solid growth in Total Loans, Shares, Assets and Net Worth, a loan portfolio that was 99.84% current, and return on assets (ROA) of .97%.

In addition to being a strong financial partner for our members, we are mindful of our responsibility to be faithful stewards of God's blessings. Indeed, I believe that the most crucial principle in the whole Bible is the concept of "blessed to be a blessing." 


