Linewize—Gaggle Integration

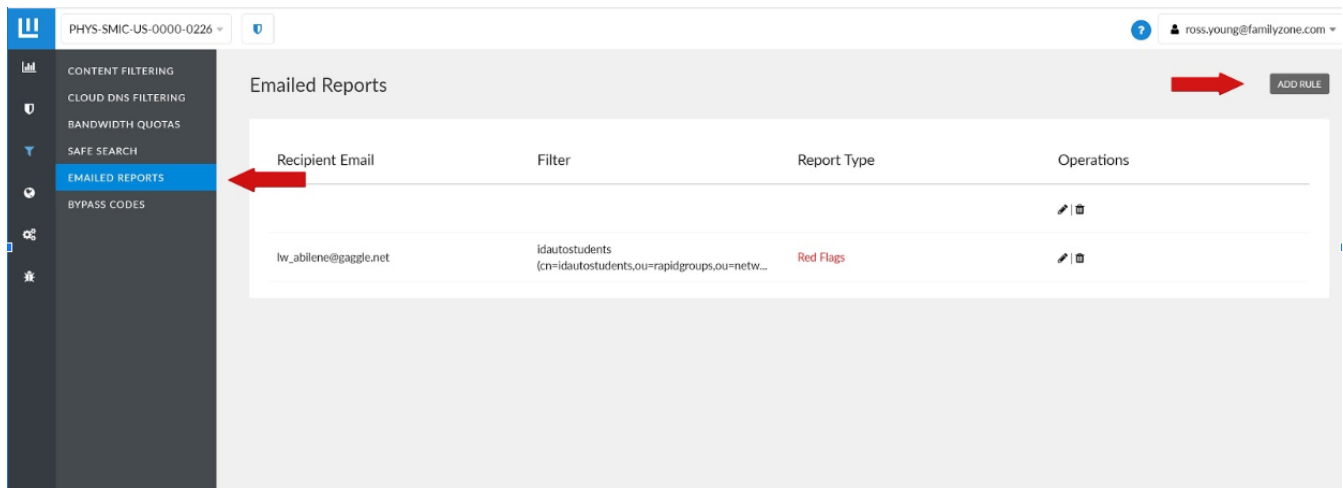
A guide to using Gaggle with Linewize School Manager

Linewize—Gaggle Integration

The Gaggle and Linewize partnership is designed to provide all web filtering search data to the Gaggle investigative team as part of your cyber safety package. This document outlines how to configure the integration.


1. Confirm with Gaggle that your licensing model supports “web filter monitoring” and obtain the Linewize Submission email. It will typically look something similar to “lw_ *yourdistrict* @gaggle.net”
2. Configure your alerts to go to Gaggle. Within the Linewize platform, navigate to Filtering > Emailed Reports and click New Rule on the top right corner.

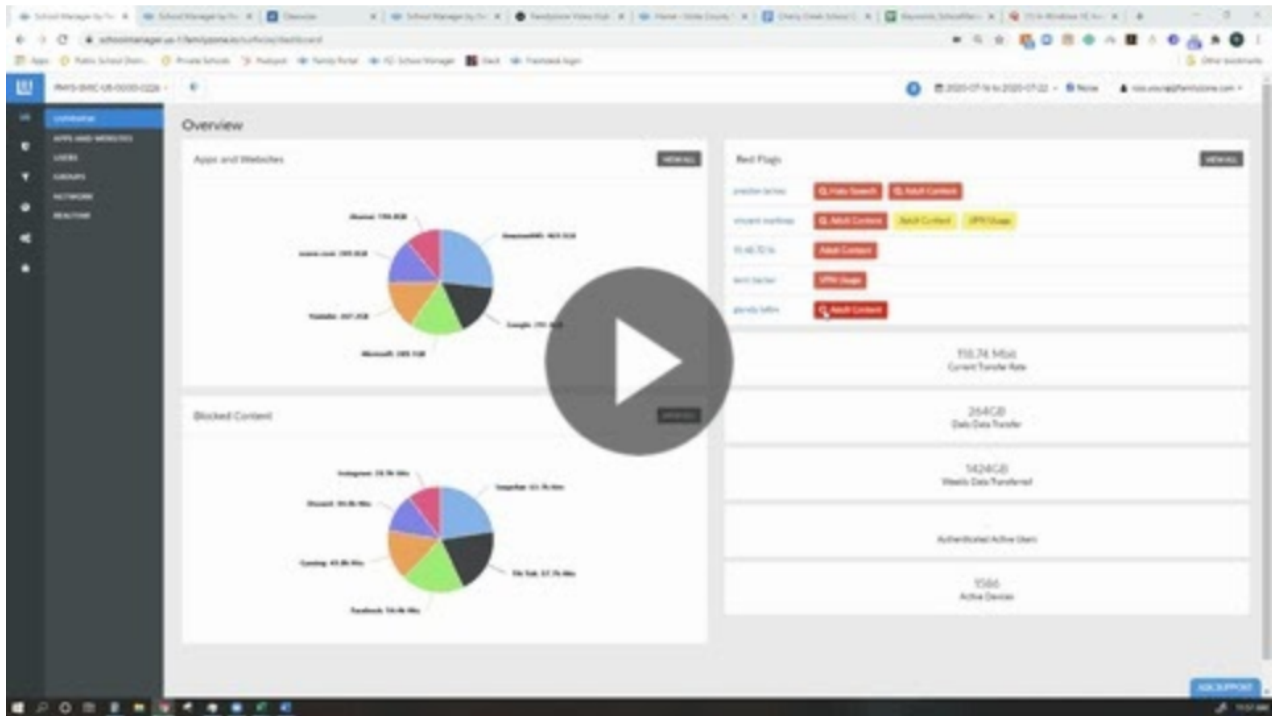
3. Set email address to lw_ *YOUR DISTRICT* @gaggle.com. Choose your “all students” groups from either AD or GSuite; do not include an OU or group that includes any staff members. Then select ALL of the search term alerts. Do not choose any categories that provide web traffic. The selection will state “SEARCH” in the selection. Select “Disable Rate Limiting.”

4. Let your Gaggle Account Manager know you have set up the integration.

What will Gaggle do after the integration?

When Linewize flags a student Internet search for words that may signal potentially dangerous or harmful behavior, an alert will be sent to the Gaggle Safety Team who will review it and determine if it should be forwarded to the school or district.

If the team classifies it as a questionable content search, the alert will be emailed to the school or district. If the alert shows an imminent threat to the student's life or well-being, the Gaggle Safety Team will immediately notify the school's or district's specified contact by phone.
