Grade Access: Cannot access grades.Grades / Bus: Grades still not up to date. Bus schedule continues to be an issue.	In an attempt to purchase a new system that was more adequate for family information, there was a huge data access block between the MNPS, Schoolrunner and STRIVE. We have been working around the clock trying to get every student updated, so teachers can continue to put
	grades in. Students will be able to redo or make-up any assignments because of the lack of communication through our new system.

Bus Feedback: It was a great idea to separate the car riders into 5th/6th and 7th/8th. The problem with the plan is the 7th/8th car riders share the spot with the buses. When bus riders load quickly, then it is a minor delay and no big deal. However, the bus sat for 20 minutes before leaving today. This is a little frustrating to parents waiting. Is it possible/ feasible for buses to park and wait adjacent to the fenced playground area. They could park side by side, with a gap in between for students to load. Then delays would not impact 7th/8th grade car riders.	This is truly an adult issue with staff not paying attention.
