The All Blacks involve team members in rituals that point to their shared history, reminding and reigniting their collective identity and purpose.


Their team culture is unique, and is based on their values as national icons and a rugby team. This is part of creating the legacy that others will inherit.

Workplace Safety



Project: Food & Beverage Packaging Facility

Our client is a Global company who leads the way in food and beverage packaging.

Challenge: Our client was moving into a new site and had a very tight timeframe to get operational. Level 4 Lockdown added another challenge to this project as we had to produce the product and install during a strict lockdown period. Because our client was an essential service and Vanguard were supporting essential services throughout Level 4, we were able to carry out the needed site scoping and installation in a timely manner.

Solution: Vanguard went on site to consult with the safety management team, scoping out requirements to come up with a walkway plan. Following our consultation service, we provided a proposal that involved Line Marking, truck exclusion zones, and our WalkSafe Traffic Barrier along the walkways to safely segregate vehicles and pedestrians.

Result: Walkways were clearly defined with line marking and well-protected by our barrier system which created an effective safety outcome for everyone on site. By turning the project around quickly and getting everything up and running, our client was able to move in on time and carry on with their operations. The whole project took 6 days from date of order to completion and the client was able to transition smoothly in to business as usual from day 1 on their new site. Our client's Project Manager who oversaw this project said, "Your turnaround time from the award of the business to delivery in the current market conditions was exceptional."

Project: Public Pedestrian Safety

Our client is an international traffic management company.

Challenge: Our client needed to keep pedestrians from walking onto a busy road that had trucks and other vehicles travelling along it. The public were jaywalking across the busy road creating a safety risk.

Solution: Vanguard consulted with the safety management team, scoping out requirements to come up with a plan. We recommended the installation of our WalkSafe Handrail System to keep pedestrians from jaywalking and Pause Gates at crossing points to guide them through to safe crossing areas away from moving traffic

Result: The installation of 650m of our WalkSafe Handrail System resulted in the safe separation of vehicles and pedestrians on this busy road. Our Pause Gates forced pedestrians to a stop before walking out on the crossing zones. Drivers can now travel down this road without concern of pedestrians stepping off the footpath and pedestrians are safely directed along the roadside.



Civil & Roading

It has been a challenging few months for the Roading industry but we are excited to see more projects locked in for the summer. Case Study: Temporary Traffic Management

Challenge: In October 2019 a major slip on State Highway 4 around Matahiwi (Te Ore Ore) destroyed a large section of the road, forcing its closure. Vanguard Group were called upon to consult with Higgins Palmerston North on managing traffic along the highway section that was disrupted.

Solution: Our solution involved the supply of our Traffic Separator Systems for the project, to assist with the management of vehicles in the area while Higgins repaired the road. The reflective flexible posts have a quick release system allowing easy removal and installation. They can be fixed for permanent use or loose-laid for temporary situations.

Result: Malcolm Chiles, the Emergency Works Recovery Manager, who was the main point of contact for this project, confirmed that the Traffic Separator Systems were "very good compared to the [more common] traffic cones".

Thanks to the proactive approach from Higgins and the safety solutions provided by Vanguard Group, this hazardous area of road was able to be used by vehicles over an extended period of time and the lengthy detour avoided.
