<b>Problem:</b>	
<b>When the documentary said...</b>	<b>I was thinking...</b>
...12–15 year olds often work 10–12 hours a day, six days a week during the hot summer...	
...many kids have to work in order to have a place to live, food, and clothing...	
...farmers have to hire cheap labor in order to keep the cost of food low...	
...hard work will help the kids later in life...	
...that children and their parents work in fields 10–12 hours a day but earn little money, and no healthcare or other benefits...	
...that the only hope for children who do not want to face a future of farm labor is for them to get an education...
