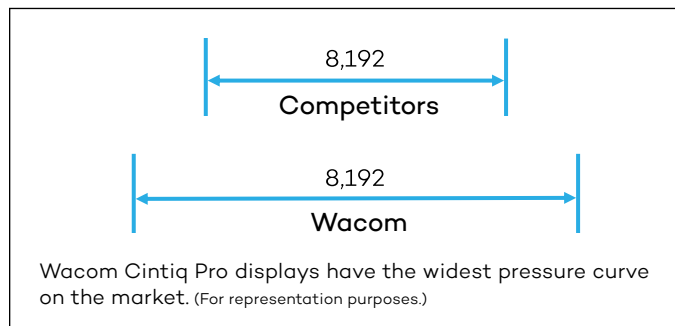
1. Pen accuracy & performance

The power of the pen

Whether you're sculpting, sketching or retouching, you'll find every stroke you make is as you intended with Wacom pen technology. We've spent decades working with professional artists to ensure the pen-to-screen experience is seamless.

Pressure sensitivity

For expert-level work that's highly detailed, you want the most pressure sensitivity you can get. The Wacom Pro Pen 2 has 8,192 levels of pressure, a four-fold improvement over previous generations. It's more sensitive, more accurate and more responsive than any pen we've ever made. If you prefer to draw or sculpt with more force, you can adjust the pressure curve to a level that feels most natural for your work style.



Our tip sensor constantly reacts to the changing force of your hand. This means a lower starting pressure for feather light sensitivity and a higher maximum pressure for those with a heavier hand, plus every type of stroke in between.

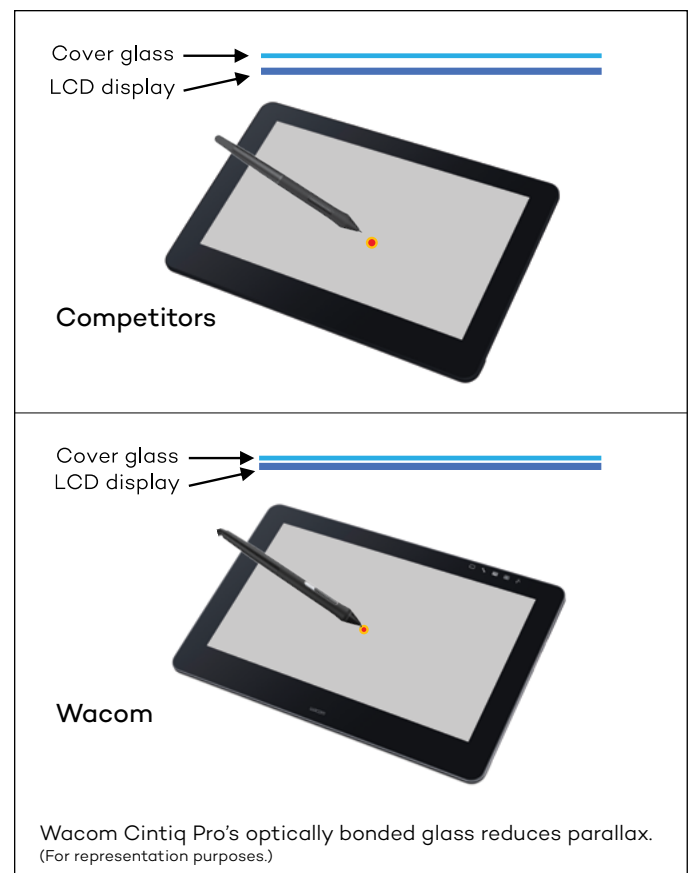
Accuracy

The Wacom Cintiq Pro takes precision a notch above with optically bonded glass that ensures the pen tip is exactly where you want it on screen. No gap. No delay. The tip of your pen renders consistently from one side of the screen to the other with virtually no parallax.

For blending colors and textures, and applying filters and brush-based strokes, only a Wacom Pro Pen enables you to find just the right width and opacity—impossible with a mouse.

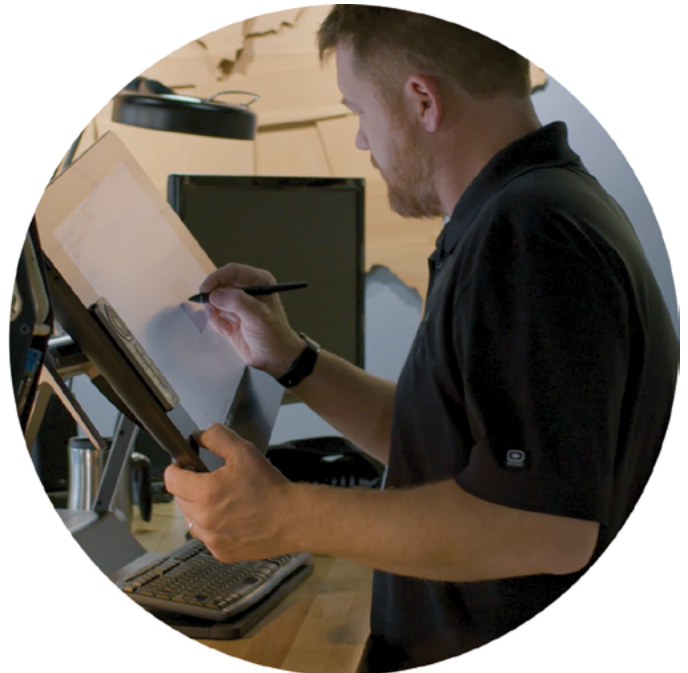
Wacom Pro Pen slim

For working in CAD and 3D creative applications like ZBrush and Autodesk® Maya® the Wacom Pro Pen 3D comes with three buttons to give you full navigational control in your 3D applications. If you prefer a slimmer form factor, the Wacom Pro Pen slim emulates the feel of a thinner brush or pencil.

With a mouse, you're essentially locked down into one position. Wacom pen technology lets you move around and get comfortable, and take advantage of all the features available in your favorite design applications.

Ergo Stand: Firm and flexible

Designed specifically for the Wacom Cintiq Pro 24/32, the Ergo stand provides a solid yet flexible foundation for your pen display. Made of durable metal, it can withstand any amount of pressure and movement without sway or wobble.

Want to work at different angles? The Ergo stand lets you change it up during the day. Raise, tilt and rotate the pen display to the perfect angle to fit your natural workflow. Lay it nearly flat on your desk or raise it to a straight-up position. Or pull it up higher and tilt it to create a stable surface—just like drawing at a drafting table.

Flex Arm: More real estate to create

When you need to spread out and create, you want more surface area and less clutter. The Wacom Cintiq Pro Flex Arm is a convenient way to elevate your Cintiq Pro display, freeing up your desktop for other tools of your trade.

Specifically designed with Ergotron for the Cintiq Pro 24 and 32, the Flex Arm is sturdy enough to support the pressure from your hand drawing on screen – no wobble or bounce.

Mount your display on your desk, the edge of your desk, or have a free-floating monitor with an extended reach of 30". Then incline, pan and rotate your display to any angle that's most comfortable to reduce the strain on your eyes, neck and back. You can even tighten the joints to your liking so your chosen angle stays put.

Rotate the display as you'd move a sheet of paper to design at a fresh angle. Even bring the Cintiq Pro over the edge of your desk to work in your lap and let the arm support the weight of the display.
