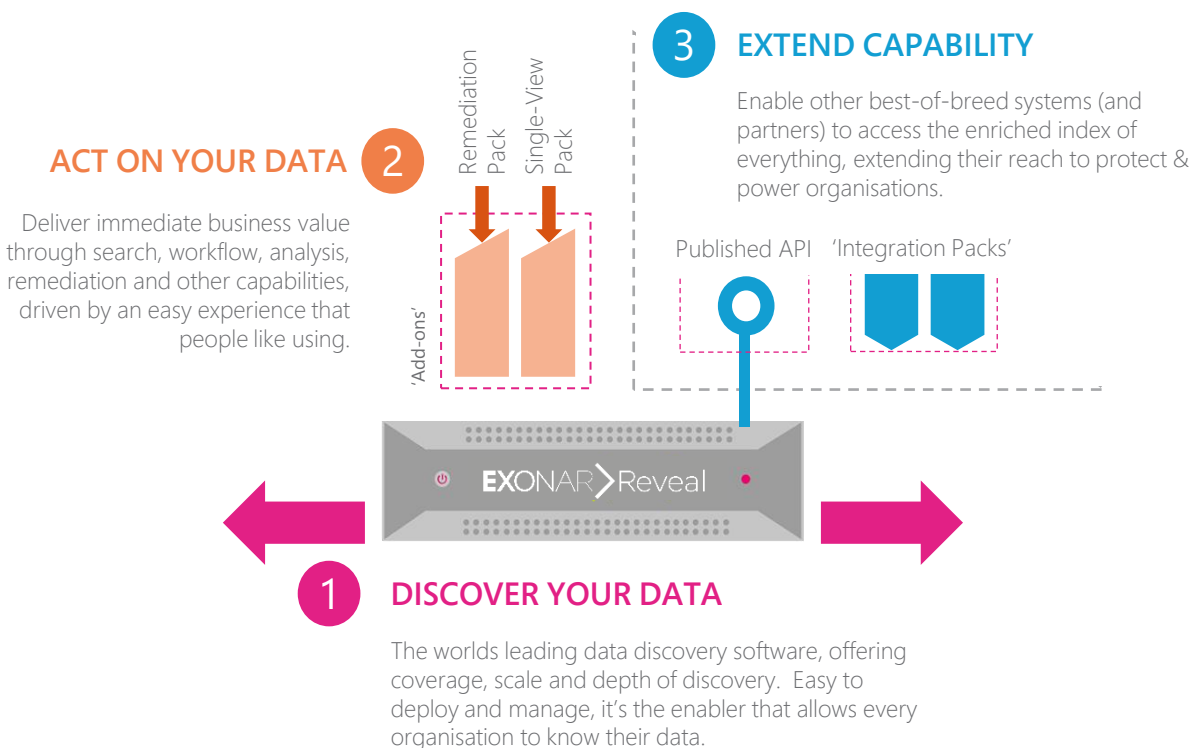

> New features in 4.4.0

This release brings enhancements and new features focused on improving day-to-day management and support of the Exonar Reveal platform.

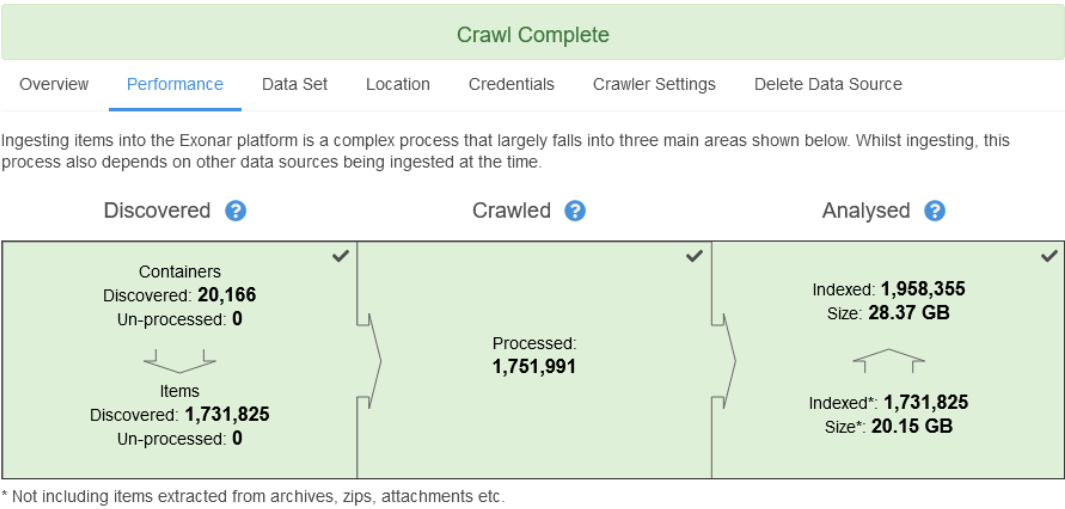
RF-1038 File Share Data Source Validation & Browsing

When creating a File Share Data Source it is now possible to validate the details and detect any errors before you start ingesting. You can now also browse folders to choose the ones you want to ingest without having to know the file path.

RF-1049 Crawl Job Progress Tracking

Information is now displayed on the progress of a crawl job. Ingested items are tracked through three phases, 'Discovered', 'Crawled' and 'Analysed', and the numbers of items currently in each phase are shown.

RF-1051 System Overview (Phase 1)

The new System Overview feature on the System page provides a summary of information about the hardware, software, and network you are using with Exonar Reveal.

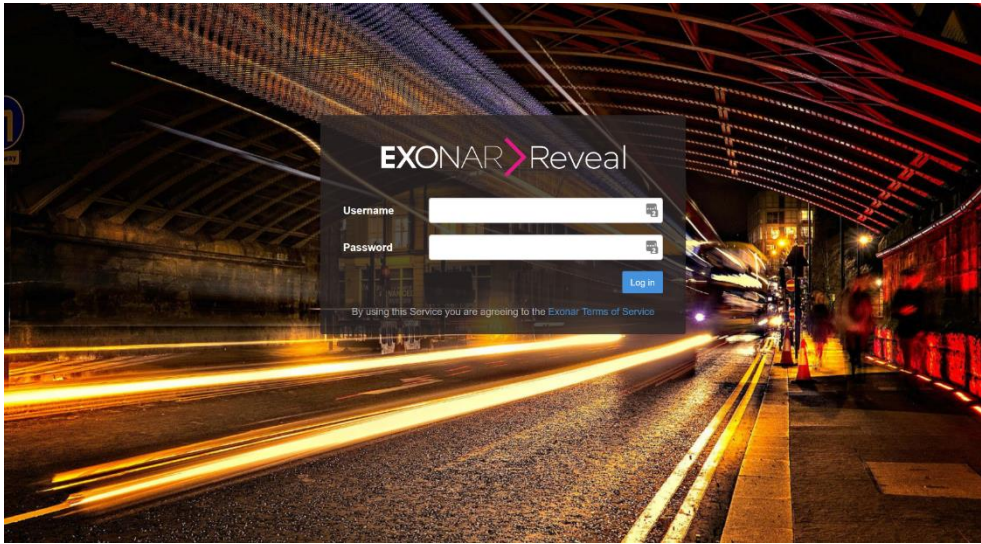
RF-1173 Platform Operations Telemetry

The new Telemetry feature on the Systems Page allows users with a Security Manager role to view/download reports on important platform details and metrics. A new report is automatically produced every 30 days or you can manually generate a report at any time.

> Other enhancements in 4.4.0

As well as adding new features in this release, we've made some minor enhancements to improve the way existing features work.

1	You can now add an optional custom job description (up to 1,000 characters long) to newly created Data Sources.
2	SMB Connector browsing functionality has been added when creating a File Share Data Source.
3	You can now input zero values in the integer range in the advanced query fields.
4	Topic extraction is now limited to the first 250Kb of the item text by default. This dramatically increases the performance of topic extraction with a minimal reduction in accuracy.

> Issues fixed in 4.4.0

We have fixed issues in this release that were raised in a previous release.

1	Those users with the 'Security Manager' role are no longer able to grant self-permissions and add their own account to a security group.
2	When ingesting structured data, the Database Schema was previously not visible. The schema will now be included for items that have changed or are new when the crawl is next run. Existing crawls do not have their description updated to include the schema on upgrade.
3	An error which led to numbers not displaying correctly on the X axis of the Risk Dashboard File Type chart has been fixed.
4	In Exchange 365 and OneDrive crawl overviews, the email address "undefined@domain.com" was shown when the ingestion scope was "Domain". This has been changed to show Office 365 detail information.
5	Crawls that are stopped will now display as "stopped" instead of "done".



> What next?

Important notes about this release

- Exonar SMB data source crawl jobs MUST be completed or stopped before upgrading
- Legacy crawls no longer show job progress\crawl count during or after crawls.
