

The AMO Application Approval Process

WHAT IS REQUIRED TO APPLY FOR A ROTATION WITH AMO?

Applying for rotations is easy and free. For most AMO rotations, only a CV, resume, or comparable information need to be submitted when you create your account. For select rotations additional documentation, such as a transcript or diploma and letter of intent, may be required.

WHO REVIEWS APPLICATIONS?

Applications that require only a resume, CV, or comparable information are generally processed for approval by AMO. Applications that require additional documentation are submitted for approval to the supervising physician or institution hosting the rotation.

HOW CAN I IMPROVE MY CHANCES OF BEING ACCEPTED?

An organized, well-written resume or CV can greatly increase an applicant's chance of approval. This is especially important for applications that are reviewed by a supervising physician or institution. This document should include information on your education, past experiences (clinical, research, or educational) that pertain to the program you are being considered for, and relevant employment in the medical field.

WHEN WILL I BE NOTIFIED IF I AM ACCEPTED?

Applications processed through AMO usually take 24 business hours. After this time frame you should receive an email notification if you have been accepted. Applications that require approval from a supervising physician or institution take at least five business days to be processed.

WHAT IS THE NEXT STEP AFTER I RECEIVE NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE?

After you have been accepted into an AMO rotation, you will be prompted to sign the clinical terms and reserve your spot. Reserving requires you to submit a down payment of the rotation fee. You can also pay for the rotation in full at this time. Reserving your rotation ensures another student interested in the same experience cannot fill the position. It also allows you to be matched with a visitor experience coach who will assist you in enrolling and preparing for your rotation in the U.S.
