WHAT ARE THE ASSOCIATED FEES?

Pre-med shadowing experiences last four weeks and cost between \$1,499 and \$2,799. The cost of a clinical experience covers the rotation, physician fees, and the processing of payments and enrollment documents. It also includes support from a personal AMO Coach and a letter of completion from AMO.

Housing, meals, transportation, airfare, and health insurance are not included in this cost. Once you reserve your experience with us, your AMO Coach can provide recommendation for where to obtain such items at a reasonable cost.
