



## Alaska state travel requirements

### What you need to know before departing home for your trip.

- You will have to submit a travel declaration showing proof of a negative COVID-19 test to enter the state of Alaska. More information can be found at the following website: <https://covid19.alaska.gov/travelers/>. In time, proof of vaccination may become an option; however, currently all travelers, even those who have received a COVID-19 vaccination, must provide a negative COVID-19 test.
- We encourage you to look into testing sites in your area, ideally those offering a 72-hour turnaround (or less) that will work with your travel plans.
- We will do our best to keep you updated as travel restrictions may change at any time.

## Book with confidence

### Our updated policies allow for greater flexibility.

- In light of COVID-19, we have instated the following policies.
  - Book with a 10% reservation deposit. This deposit is nonrefundable, but up until one month before your charter, it can be rolled over to a 2022 charter without penalty.
  - Full payment is due 120 days before your trip. If your trip might be affected by the status of the Canadian border closure, we will not require your final payment until the border is open.
  - For cancellations received prior to 120 days before your trip, and up to one month prior to your trip, you may choose to roll your funds over into a future charter without penalty.
- **Please note: Take additional precautions in preparation for and during your travels to meet your boat in Alaska! If you arrive in Alaska and test positive for COVID-19 upon arrival, you will be unable to participate in the Flotilla, and your trip will not be refunded or rolled over.**
- We maintain a list of Travel Insurance agencies, and highly recommend you look into insuring your trip against unforeseen circumstances which could arise.
