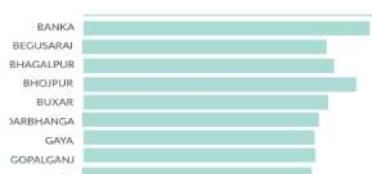

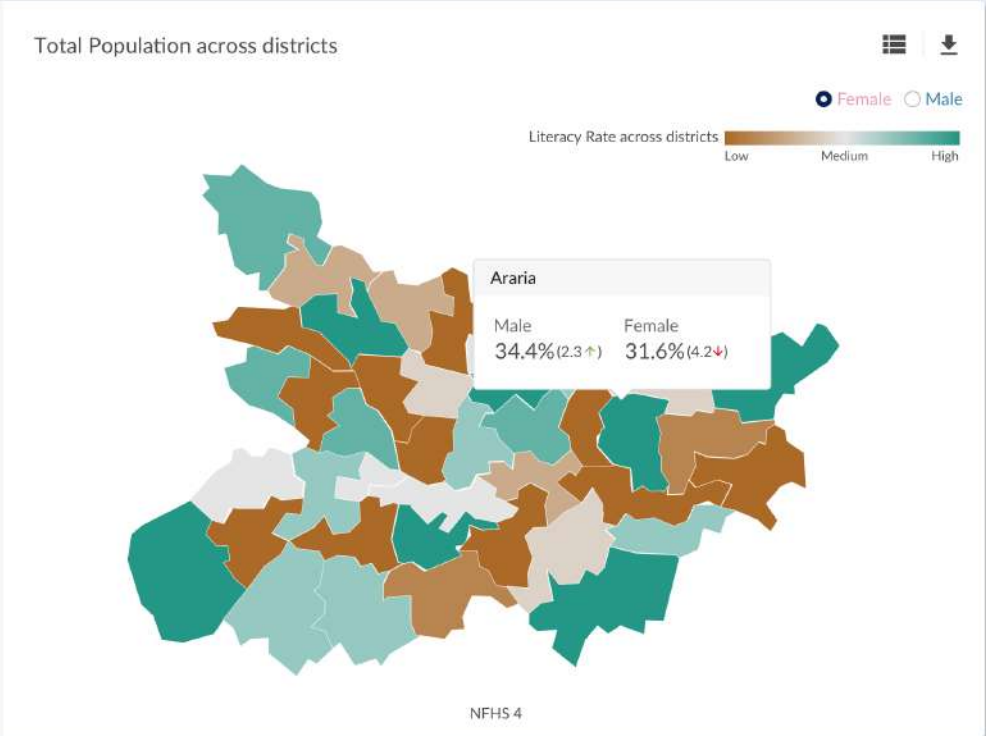

Nutrition Health Care

Nutrition plays an important role for women or pregnant women. Below indicators are tracked to monitor the balanced diet and good nutrition

- Mothers who consumed iron folic acid for 100 days or more when they were pregnant (%) 34.5%
- Women whose Body Mass Index (BMI) is below normal (BMI < 18.5 kg/m2) (%) 34.5%
- Non-pregnant women age 15-49 years who are anaemic (<12.0 g/dl) (%) 44.3%
- Pregnant women age 15-49 years who are anaemic (<11.0 g/dl) (%) 34.5%
- Women who received supplementary nutrition 34.5%

FP Use

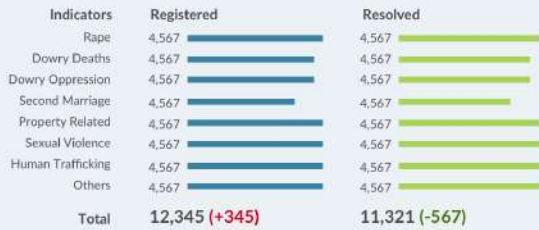

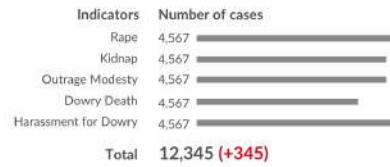
