


What, who, where, when, how










What are you doing? (O que você está fazendo?) What subject is this book in your hand? (De qual matéria é este livro na sua mão?)

"When" é a palavra usada para perguntar sobre tempo, datas e ocasiões.

When are you going home? (Quando você irá pra casa?)

When is your birthday? (Quando é o seu aniverário?)

When are you going home today? When is your birthday? It's coming, isn't it?

Hmm, I think I'm going home after lunch time! We can go together. And my bithday is next week, on September 16th.





Who are you going to invite to your party?

Hmm, I'm not sure I will have a party this year....But if I do, I think I will invite Hanna, Kevin and Blake. And you, of course.

"Who" é a palavra usada para perguntar sobre pessoas.

Who are you going to invite to your party? (Quem você vai chamar pra sua festa?)





"How" é a palavra usada para perguntar sobre a maneira ou jeito algo está ou que algo foi feito.

How is your mother?

(Como está a sua mãe?)

How are you going to school today?

(Como você irá para a escola hoje?)

How is your mother? How are you going to school today? Maybe I can give you a ride.

My mother? She's fine. What about yours? I'm going by car. So, in this case, if you prefer, I also can give you a ride.






"Where" é a palavra usada para perguntar sobre localização em geral.

Where is your mother Oh, I'm sorry bu it will now? Is she home? I have to wait. My mother would love to see her! is at work right now and she gets home really late. Next time?







