Para dizer as datas, usamos a preposição **IN** se falarmos apenas o mês. E usamos **ON** quando falamos a data completa (mês e dia).

Christmas is **in December**.

Christmas is
on December twenty-fifth.



Uma curiosidade!

Ao contrário do americano, no inglês britânico, o dia vem antes do mês.

The second of May. (britânico)
May second. (americano)
