As we get set to kick off the 2nd semester, I ask your help in the following areas as reminders:

Per KHDA guidelines, parents and guardians have 10 minutes to collect children after school. If you are perpetually late, as I remain with kids past 4:00 in the reception for safety, you can be fined and you could risk being dismissed from the school. It is a safety issue and can be considered neglect. This is especially important on Fridays as it is UAE Law that everyone leaves by 12:00, staff, teachers and Leaders.

Please ensure your child is coming with a charged device everyday. They should bring the charger along to school.

Please ensure your child has a water bottle and that they have plenty of masks with them in their possession.

Please reinforce that the mask MUST be worn at all times, above the nose, except while eating and drinking. If scholars cannot or refuse to comply, they will receive disciplinary consequences, such as being told to stay home. The risk is just too great and we need everyone's cooperation.

If you are having questions or concerns, please contact the classroom teacher for all things academic. If they are unresolved, please contact me.

Please give grace and be flexible with new teachers, and with any kind of Distance Learning. Teachers will need to adjust their own settings in Google Calendar, and these things take time. Going into a hybrid format is temporary, so please let's get back to Face to Face, as the DHA and KHDA permissions are still in effect. As a school, we will remain flexible as well. We have to, as the whole world is in this together. Ignite is no different right now than any other school on the planet, international or public.



We really need scholars only to carry books and items home that they need. Please do not let scholars have a roller bag. It is much too bulky and heavy for our scholars.

Spend time with your child at home asking them what they did, what they learned about, what homework they may have or any upcoming projects, tests or quizzes. Ask them to show you their yellow daily planner!

I realize there is a lot of information coming forward, especially in times where we must be vigilant with regard to the Pandemic to keep us open for optimal learning environments. However, if we aren't reading and staying in touch, there is a greater chance that things will not be understood and there is confusion.

I thank you for your continued support, especially this school year where around the world it's been ever more challenging than last year. We will continue to do the best we can, even when there are mistakes.
