cross-docking?



Cross-docking is a practice in transportation logistics of unloading materials from an incoming semi-trailer or railroad car and loading these materials directly into outbound trucks, trailers or rail cars, with little or no storage in between.

This may be done to change the type of conveyance, to allow for ease of transport across the U.S./Mexico border, to sort material intended

for different destinations or to combine material from different origins into transport vehicles (or containers) with the same or similar destinations.




are we typically hauling?
