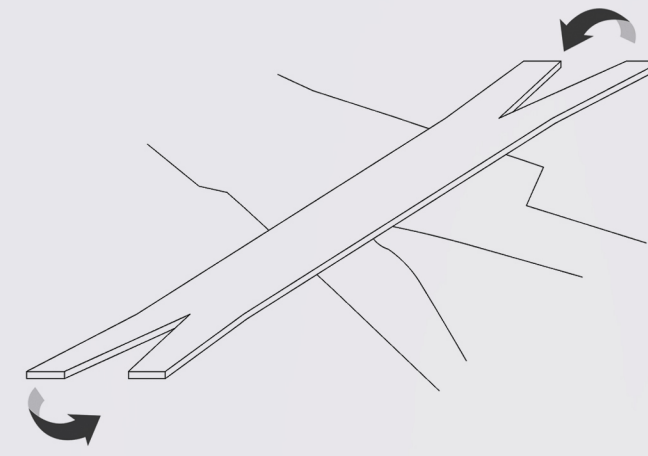
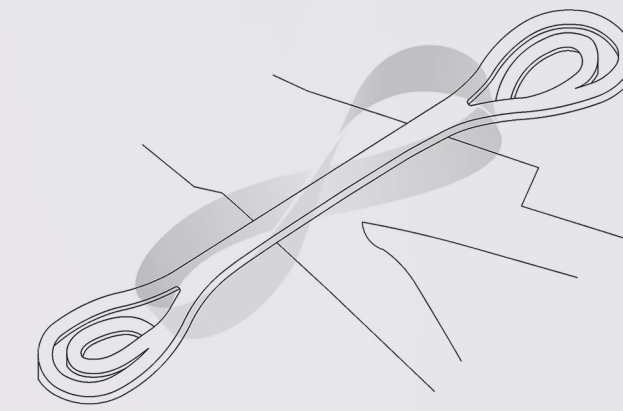


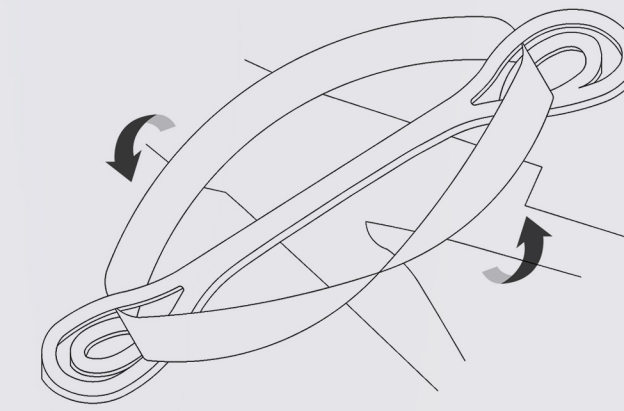
Connecting the east and west plazas with a bridge.



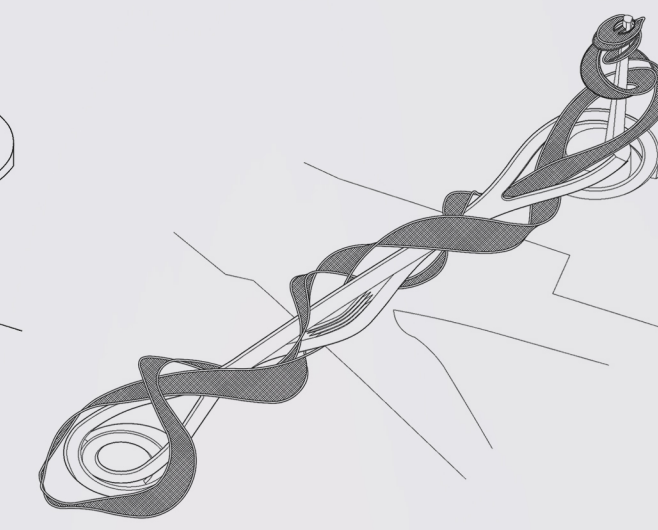
Translating the confluence of the Guadalupe river & Las Gatos creek onto the bridge.

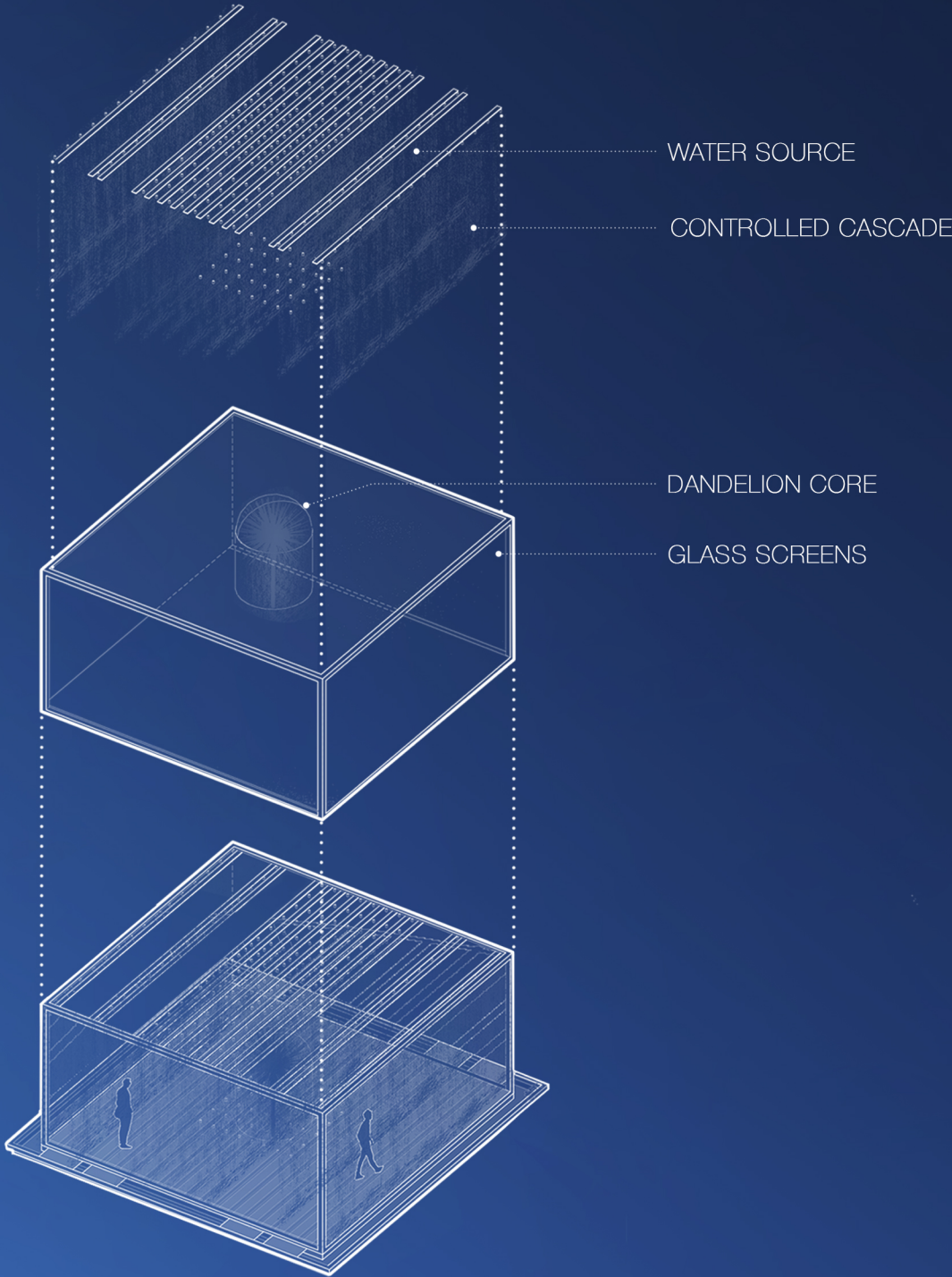


SILICON CHIP
WATER SCULPTURE

The Silicon chip water sculpture allows visitors to walk through a controlled cascade and experience the monumentality of water within a simple cube.

A dandelion fountain lies at the center of the cube that simulates the energy core of a silicon chip.

The cube is centered amongst water channels and bioluminescent pathways - all inspired by the ubiquitous silicon chip - the product that gave Silicon Valley its name.

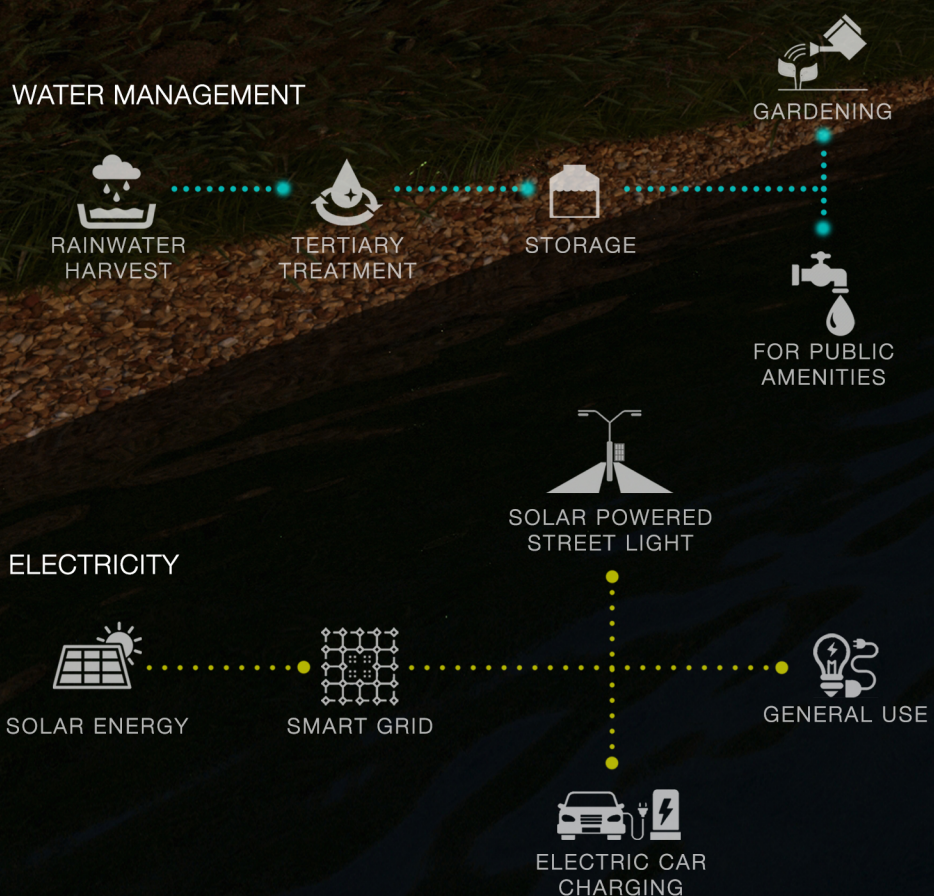

RIBBON MESH DETAIL

Carbon fibre framework.

Cross laminated timber battens attached to the main frame with metal fasteners.

Wrapped with a hybrid wicker & recycled aluminum mesh weave.
