

In the most important Urban park in Silicon Valley, the Confluence of the Guadalupe River and Los Gatos Creek reified itself.

The confluence of two elements, conventionally speaking, allows for both of them to be more successful, to think bigger, to double up forces to become more influent and powerful.

A structure of metal alloy - a combination of one and more elements. Blending proprieties of each one leads to a new substance with increased – strength and hardness.

A path follows the main direction of motion in the park and goes below the slope, passing through the structures. The main pedestrian slope spans around the structure.

The sculpture – the main two lines raise to the maximum 200 feet above the ground, a cooper ramp brings them together again to follow along an imaginary asymptote towards the sky.
