Project Summary

A place where different public spaces serve as meeting up points or spaces to enjoy San Jose skyline.

Sculptural geometry whit a big opening that relates with a bigger urban scale. Two contrasting façades providing an abstract and striking image

Recyclable construction materials with low CO2 footprint. Façade louvres to avoid solar gains and roof gardens providing thermal insulation and biodiversity.

The minimized tower footprint avoids existing greenery removal. Timber façades and roof gardens to integrate the tower in the environment.

Subtle lighting from inner façade render the building a beacon without disturbance for the nearby wildlife or air traffic
