In San Joes, this light tower becomes an iconic destination where shows the human culture starting point and most developed technology. It reveals the sunlight and stand for a strong visual presence during daytime and nighttime. It reflects the color of the city and environment. Under the tower, there are café and public area with landscape design around.





The optical fiber embedded in the stone transmits sunlight and lighten the bottom surface. For the viewers from a distance, they can see many beams of sunlight in the haze. When they move closely, clusters of light in the stone appears. When they enter the tower, in the dark surroundings, they are crowded by starry lights. In this process, viewer can appreciate the sunlight of the presence, falling down from the sky.
