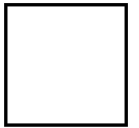
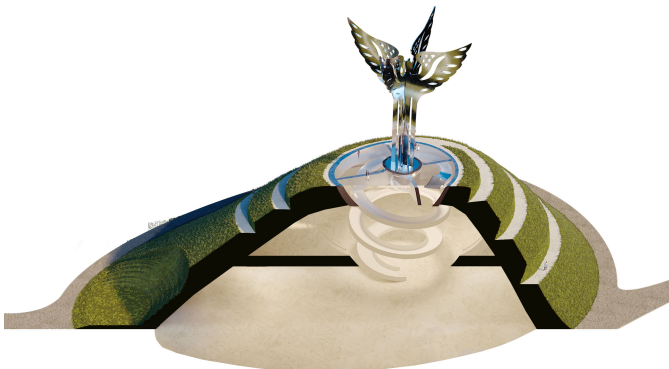

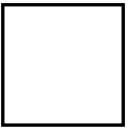
ANGEL OF HOPE



Esperanza will be seen from miles away across Santa Clara Valley as she rises 100' atop the 80' hill. The project uses net-zero design: recycled materials, photovoltaic technology, and the capture of rain run-off to irrigate the park and cool interior spaces.



Spaces for community events, exhibitions, and multimedia presentations. Environmental and conservancy offices, rest rooms, a gift shop, and a café on the lower level. Wheelchair and pedestrian friendly spiraling ramp will lead to the Summit Plaza above.



Paths from the hill will lead visitors over two bridges to the East side of the park, where three viewing mounds with star-shaped patios on top will rise up to 40' high. These mounds could be used for a playground, a picnic area, and a maze.
