Ohlone Memorial Arched Walkways

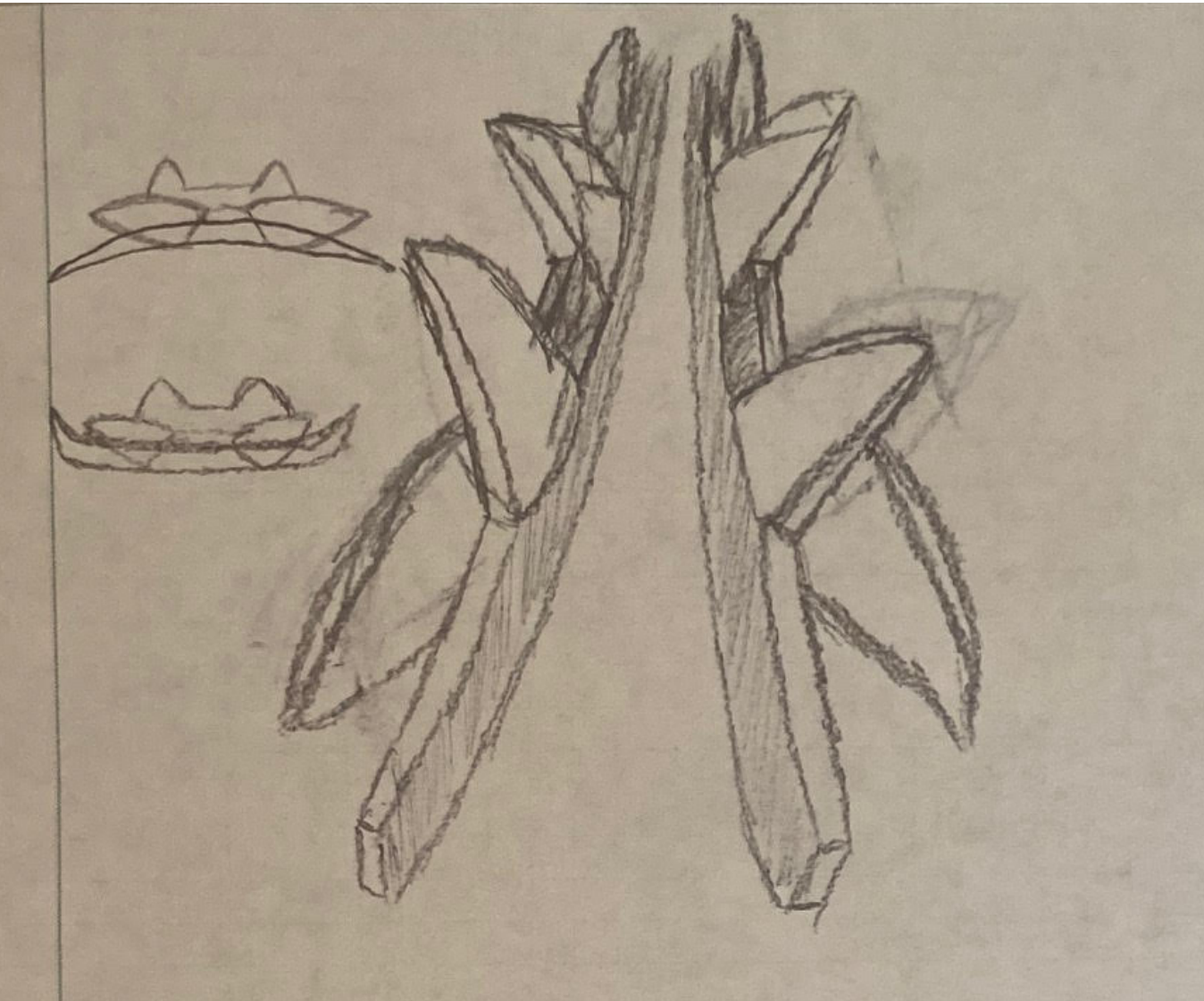

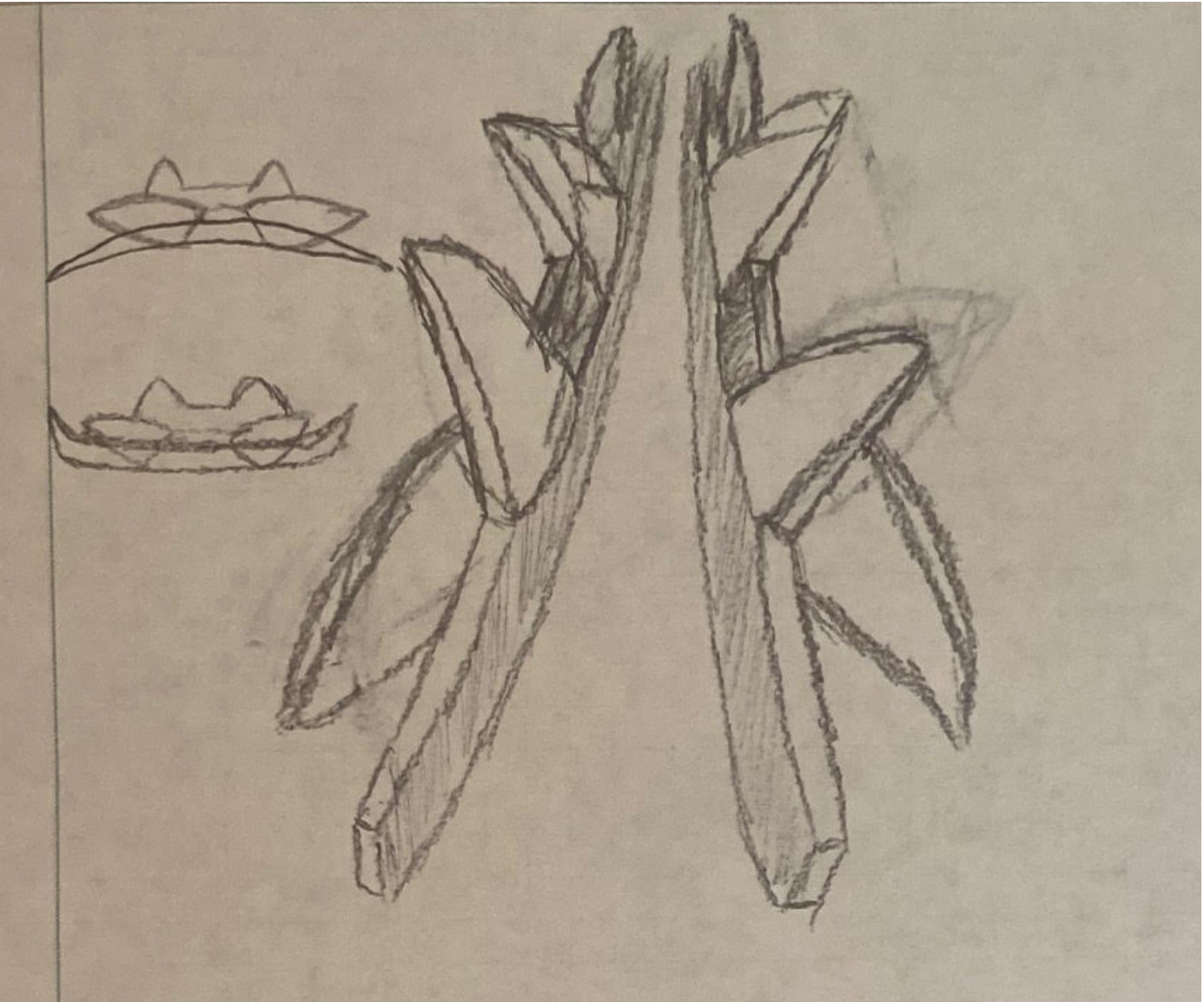


Final Arched Walkway Design

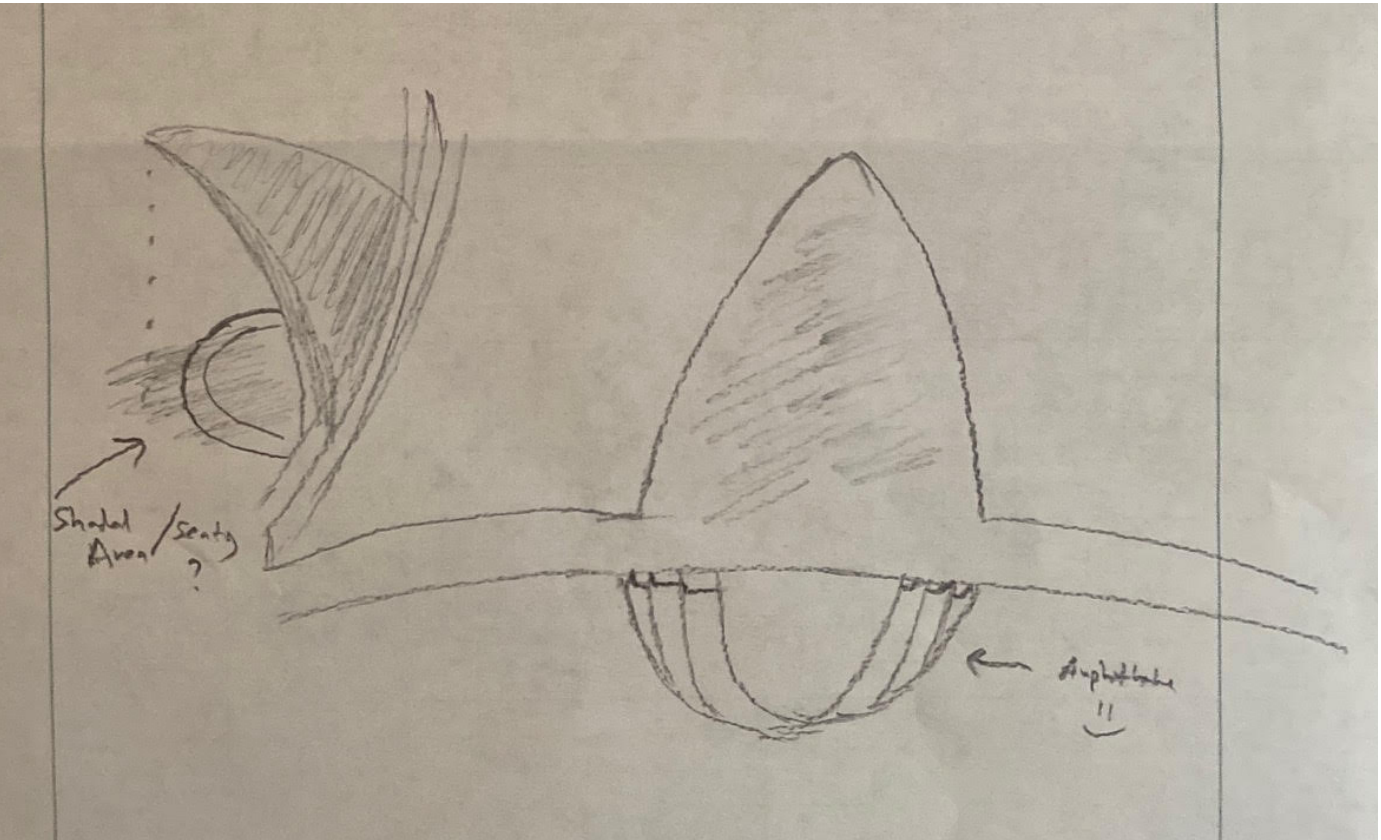
