

The Homunculus can be made of acrylic pipes with different transparency, with built-in LED illumination or lasers, from plastic pipes or metal pipes (possibly recycled art), with external illumination. A smoke machine (steam generator) can be installed inside the pipes, an object can sound like “wind music” or play music, or it can even be a waterfall.

The Homunculus will not only consume, but also generate energy from the sun, the wind and the viewers interacting with it.

From a professional point of view, it is important for us to strive for this goal and to promote decisions that are economical, environmentally friendly, aesthetic and friendly to the inhabitants and visitors of the park.

At this stage, it is difficult to calculate which clean energy options - zero will be exactly what we want.

Interaction with the viewer occurs when approaching it, but only a group of people can turn on the object (for example, if at least 3 people get into the right place).

The Homunculus comes to life with light, sound and smoke (steam), immersing the viewer in his wonderful world - something has come!

The facility itself or structures nearby can be an interactive museum.
